



#### Where Go the Boats?

Boats set sail and float on, "Away down the river / A hundred miles or more," passing sandy shores and green trees, to be admired by others. Readers will delight in this fold-out board book edition of Robert Louis Stevenson's classic children's verse, accompanied here by wistful yet lighthearted artwork by Chris Sheban.

Known for such classic works as Treasure Island and The Strange Case of Dr. Jekyll and Mr. Hyde, Robert Louis Stevenson (1850-94) was a popular Scottish poet, playwright, novelist, and historian.

Chris Sheban has illustrated a number of notable children's books for Creative Editions, including Beyond the Stars, What to Do with a Box, I Met a Dinosaur, and A Night on the Range. His work has been honored with three gold and three silver medals from the Society of Illustrators. He lives near Chicago.





#### Seashell




#### Virginia Was a Spy




#### Me + Tree




#### Wilderness

John Muir dedicated the better part of his adult life to advocacy especially for the wild landscapes of the American West. More than 100 years after his death, the impulse to protect such irreplaceable natural wonders is still strong. Combining some of Muir's most memorable and inspirational words with evocative imagery, Wilderness reminds us of our shared responsibility and inescapable bond. We are global citizens. The entire universe is home.

Born in Scotland, John Muir (1838–1914) immigrated to the United States in 1849. His extensive travels eventually led him to California, where he fell in love with the Yosemite Valley and also found a family with wife Louisa Strentzel and their two daughters. Muir helped found the Sierra Club in 1892 and penned many letters, essays, and books.

Italian artist Giovanni Manna has created illustrations for more than 80 children's books. His work has been featured in exhibitions throughout Italy and internationally. A longtime instructor of watercolor, he was awarded the Andersen Prize for best Italian illustrator in 2003.












#### The World Below the Brine

Below the brine, the salty waters of the sea, is a wonderland waiting to be explored—its wide array of plants and creatures different but not wholly unlike those that can be found on land, in the world above. Nineteenth-century poet Walt Whitman's classic verse employs the language of his day to express a wonder that is timeless, while the surrealistic imagery of James Christopher Carroll's art inspires readers to dive in for a closer look.

American poet Walt Whitman (1819-92) celebrated the wonder and wildness of both nature and humanity, leaving a towering legacy to the world with such works as Leaves of Grass. "The World Below the Brine," first published in 1860, was later included in the revised edition of Leaves of Grass.


James Christopher Carroll is an author, illustrator, and graphic designer whose picture books include A Song, recently published by Creative Editions. He lives with his family in upstate New York.












