Author Bio

Elmer Kelton (1926-2009) was the award-winning author of more than forty novels, including *The Time It Never Rained*, *Other Men's Horses*, *Texas Standoff* and *Hard Trail to Follow*. He grew up on a ranch near Crane, Texas, and earned a journalism degree from the University of Texas. His first novel, *Hot Iron*, was published in 1956. Among his awards were seven Spurs from Western Writers of America and four Western Heritage awards from the National Cowboy Hall of Fame. His novel *The Good Old Boys* was made into a television film starring Tommy Lee Jones. In addition to his novels, Kelton worked as an agricultural journalist for 42 years.
