Here, Malcolm meets other prisoners, including his mentor, Bimbi. Meanwhile, he writes letters to his family, reminiscing about childhood memories told in interspersed flashbacks. As the years go by, Malcolm grows and grapples with the nuances and intersections of race, politics, religion, and justice in 1940s America. And then, as his time in jail comes to an end, he begins to awaken. Indeed, he emerges from prison more than just a man named Malcolm Little: Now, he is Malcolm X.

Written by Malcolm X's daughter Ilyasah Shabazz and award-winning author Tiffany D. Jackson, here is an intimate look at Malcolm X's young adult years. While this book chronologically follows *X: A Novel*, it can be read as a thoughtful stand-alone, a necessary historical novel that invites larger discussions on the timely themes of black power, prison reform, and civil rights.
