



This book invites readers into the homes of seventeen legendary and contemporary artists. Writer Melissa Wyse and illustrator Kate Lewis explore the nuances of how physical spaces inspire and support artistic practice, from Georgia O'Keeffe's desert retreat at Ghost Ranch to Hassan Hajjaj's radical blend of private home, tea room, and art gallery in Marrakech. Each chapter weaves in historical and biographical context and highlights fascinating details that in turn illuminate the artist's work in a new way. The text is engaging and accessible, and the illustrations invite readers into the feeling of the space in a way photographs cannot. An epilogue prompts readers to rethink how their own home could become a more creative space.

The Black Leopard

by Will Burrard-Lucas

There are few creatures as gorgeous and elusive as the black leopard. In Africa, these magnificent cats are so rare as to be the stuff of legend. Will Burrard-Lucas love for leopards began during his childhood in Tanzania and propelled him into a career as a wildlife photographer. In his quest to create intimate portraits of animals, he developed innovative technology, including a remotely controlled camera on wheels and a high quality camera trap system for photographing nocturnal creatures. In Kenya, he used these tools to capture the first high quality, scientifically verifiable photograph of an African black leopard in almost 100 years. In this compelling and visually stunning book, Burrard-Lucas tells his story of creativity, entrepreneurship, and passion for wild animals, alongside awe-inspiring images of lions, elephants, and the black leopard itself.

Author Bio

Will Burrard-Lucas is a British wildlife photographer. He spent part of his childhood in Tanzania where he first developed a love of nature. He developed an interest in photography whilst at university and shortly thereafter, started focusing his lens on the natural world. He became a full-time photographer in 2010.

Burrard-Lucas is an advocate for wildlife conservation and works with various conservation non-governmental organizations, including WWF, African Parks, the Tsavo Trust in Kenya, and the Ethiopian Wolf Conservation Programme. He founded the website WildlifePhoto.com to provide nature photographers with online services, products, and educational resources, and in 2009, Burrard-Lucas created the BeetleCam, a remote-control camera buggy which enables photographers to take close-up photographs of wildlife. He later created a high-quality camera trap system for photographing rare and nocturnal animals, and is the founder of Camtraptions, a company specializing in products for remote and camera trap photography.

His work has been featured by numerous international media outlets including *The New York Times*, the *Guardian*, the *Telegraph*, the *Washington Post*, *National Geographic*, CNN and BBC. Since 2015, Burrard-Lucas has focused on a long-term project to reveal African wildlife at night creating and using new photography techniques. His resulting work has been recognized in several international photography awards including GDT European Wildlife Photographer of the Year (2016, 2017), Sony World Photography Awards (2017), Travel Photographer of the Year (2019) and Siena International Photo Awards (2019)





Mango and Peppercorns

by Tung Nguyen, Katherine Manning and Lyn Nguyen

In 1975, after narrowly escaping the fall of Saigon, pregnant refugee and gifted cook Tung Nguyen ended up in the Miami home of Kathy Manning, a graduate student and waitress who was taking in displaced Vietnamese. This serendipitous meeting evolved into a decades-long partnership, one that eventually turned strangers into family and a tiny, no-frills eatery into one of the most lauded restaurants in the country. Weaving between their alternating perspectives, *Mango & Peppercorns* tells Tung and Kathy's improbable, quintessentially American story as they raise Tung's daughter, Lyn, and open the award-winning Hy Vong ("hope" in Vietnamese) together, all while navigating the challenges of immigration, assimilation, blending families, and making ends meet. Tung's fierce practicality often clashes with Kathy's free-spirited nature, but over time, they find a harmony in their contrasts - a harmony embodied in the restaurant's signature mango and peppercorns sauce. Through powerful narrative, archival imagery, and 20 Vietnamese recipes that mirror their story, *Mango & Peppercorns* is a unique contribution to culinary literature.

Tung Nguyen, who fled Vietnam almost fifty years ago, cofounded the award-winning Hy Vong, a pioneering Vietnamese restaurant in Miami. She currently cooks for select pop-ups and catered events.

Katherine Manning cofounded Hy Vong. She manages Hy Vong's pop-ups and catered events.

Lyn Nguyen is Tung Nguyen's daughter. Before earning degrees from Harvard and Cornell, she helped wait tables at Hy Vong. She is the CEO and cofounder of Liquid Analytics, an artificial intelligence innovation firm.

Elisa Ung is an award-winning writer, book collaborator, and editor. She was the restaurant critic and dining columnist for *Northjersey.com* and the (Bergen) *Record* in New Jersey, and a staff writer for the *Philadelphia Inquirer*.

Why did Jane Austen struggle to write for five years before her first novel was ever published?
