In December 1986, I boarded a plane to embark on a multi-year Spanish-speaking mission for my faith. I had just spent two months in a special language and religious study program where we immersed ourselves in Spanish 24/7 for nine weeks: up at 6:00 AM, study all day, and in bed by 10:30 PM with breaks only for breakfast, lunch, dinner, and a short exercise period. After those nine weeks, of course, I was fluent. I could conjugate at least 500 verbs and ask and answer memorized questions and responses. Fluent? Yeah, right! When I landed and went to my first assigned area, I visited my first Spanish-speaking family. After the first introductions—"Hola! Me llamo Christobal"—I had absolutely no idea at all what they were saying. "Mas despacio, por favor."

It's been nearly forty years since that experience and today I'm still speaking Spanish. Fluently? Not a chance, but I can carry on a decent conversation in my second language. Each Tuesday I volunteer as an instructor and organizer for English classes for Spanish speakers interested in improving their conversational English. It's one of my favorite things, to be in those classes and work with a tremendously intelligent, giving, hardworking, and demonstratively humorous culture. At any moment, we laugh and celebrate with *animó*. In the famous words of Nacho Libre, "I love it."

So it must come as no surprise that Familius continues to publish directly to this wonderful and growing Spanish-speaking audience. While we've ensured that many of our books are translated and published in different languages, Spanish has been a lynchpin to our international publishing strategy. This season, we are thrilled to accelerate our Spanish language program to meet the growing needs of Spanish speaking families in the United States.

Blender Hollandaise Sauce

Sauce Hollandaise au Mixer

DIFFICULTY: *

Although this is not the original Julia Child recipe from her classic cookbook, *Mastering the Art of French Cooking*, it is equally as delicious and contains the same ingredient list as the original recipe, including the use of white pepper instead of black or cayenne pepper. This sauce should be prepared immediately before serving. It will only take 3–5 minutes to complete. **Makes 1 cup.**

3 large egg yolks
1/4 teaspoon salt
1/8 teaspoon white pepper
1–2 tablespoons fresh lemon juice, or to taste
1/2 cup unsalted butter, cut into 1-inch pieces

1. Heat butter pieces in a small saucepan until bubbly. Set aside until ready to use.
2. Place eggs yolks, salt, pepper, and 1 tablespoon lemon juice in the blender. Remove the small insert in the blender's lid.
3. With the blender on low, slowly add the hot butter to the egg and lemon mixture, starting with drop-lets and then a slow stream. Blend for 30 seconds until the sauce is very thick. Taste, then add more lemon juice, salt, or white pepper as desired. Use immediately.



The difference between white and black pepper boils down to how each is processed. Black pepper is unripe peppercorn berries dried until the skins are blackened. This gives it its characteristic color, aroma, and strong bite. White pepper is fully ripened peppercorns soaked in water to ferment with the outer skin removed, then dried. This produces a lighter color, less aromatic scent, and milder bite.

Parisian Macarons

Macarons Parisiens

DIFFICULTY: ***

Makes 16–18 macarons

Macarons
1 cup powdered sugar
3/4 cup almond flour
2 large egg whites, room temperature
1/8 teaspoon cream of tartar
1/4 cup superfine sugar
Buttercream Filling
3 large egg whites
1 cup sugar
1 cup unsalted butter, room temperature

Macarons

1. Preheat the oven to 375 degrees F. Line two baking sheets with parchment paper. Trace 1-inch circles 1 inch apart on the paper to use as a guideline for piping macaron dough. Turn over the marked side of each parchment paper so that no pencil marks get on the macarons. Set aside until ready to use.
2. Pulse powdered sugar and almond flour in a food processor until combined. Sift the mixture thoroughly.
3. Whisk egg whites with a mixer on medium speed until foamy, about 3–4 minutes. Add cream of tartar and whisk until soft peaks form. Reduce speed to low and add superfine sugar. Increase speed to high and whisk until stiff peaks form, about 8 minutes.
4. Sift the flour mixture over the whipped egg whites. Fold until mixture is smooth and shiny.
5. Transfer batter to a pastry bag fitted with a 1/2-inch plain round tip. Pipe 1-inch rounds on each designated circle, dragging the pastry tip to the side of each macaron round rather than forming peaks.
6. Tap the bottom of each sheet to release trapped air. Let stand at room temperature for 15 minutes. Reduce oven temperature to 325 degrees F.
7. Bake one sheet at a time, rotating the baking sheet halfway through, until macarons are crisp and firm, about 10 minutes. After each batch, increase oven temperature to 375 degrees F, heat for 5 minutes, then reduce to 325 degrees F.
8. Let macarons cool on the sheets for 2–3 minutes and transfer to a wire rack to cool completely. (If macarons stick, spray water underneath parchment on hot sheet. The steam will help release macarons.)



Unfilled macarons can be frozen for up to 3 months in plastic wrap. Make different flavors of macarons by adding the flavor before adding the flour in the recipe. For fruit flavoring, add 1 tablespoon of fruit jam or preserves and 2 drops of the appropriate paste food color for the fruit chosen. For mint, add 1/4 teaspoon of peppermint extract and 2 drops of green food coloring.

Buttercream Filling

1. In the bowl of an electric mixer, whisk egg whites and sugar until combined.
2. Set the mixer bowl over a saucepan of simmering water and heat the mixture, whisking often, until it feels warm to the touch and the sugar is dissolved, about 3–5 minutes.
3. Transfer the bowl to the mixer and fit it with the whisk attachment. Whip on high speed until mixture is stiff and shiny, about 3–5 minutes.
4. Add butter, one piece at a time, and continue mixing until the butter is thoroughly incorporated.



The filling can be kept, covered and refrigerated, for up to a week. Bring it to room temperature before storing.



Fill and Assemble the Macarons

1. Fill a pastry bag with the buttercream and fit the bag with a 1/2-inch round tip, or fill a resealable plastic bag and snip about 1/2 inch off the bottom corner.
2. Pipe a small round in the center of one macaron (1 teaspoon or less) and top with another macaron of similar size. Continue until all the macarons are filled and assembled.
3. For variety, replace the buttercream filling with 1 teaspoon of fruit jam, Nutella, peanut butter, or other filling.
