# John Horgan

*In His Own Words*

JOHN HORGAN, WITH ROD MICKLEBURGH

*This candid, unvarnished memoir of British Columbia's most popular premier reveals a legacy of enduring value to Canadian politics and culture.*

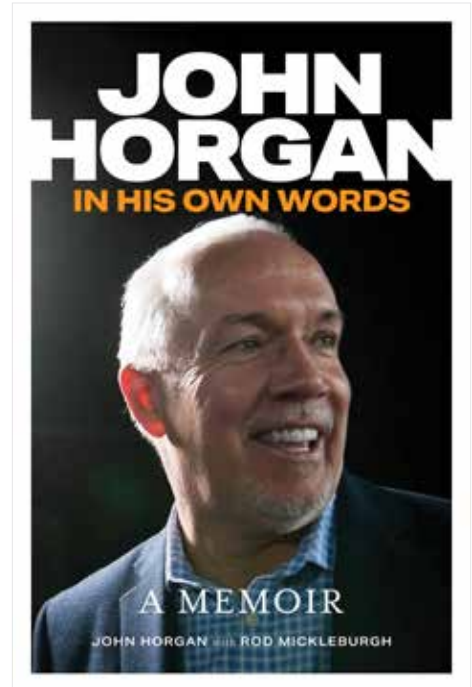
THE PUBLIC OUTPOURING OF emotion at the time of John Horgan's death in 2024 surprised few who had come to know him well. The tributes to BC's most popular premier reflected a man whose multifaceted character won admiration that deepened over time—someone both bold and unassuming, driven by principle but flexible enough to welcome ideas from across the political spectrum.

In the wake of the loss comes the unmistakable voice of Horgan himself, in this candid, piercing, often funny memoir. Here, he reveals the path that transformed him from the wayward figure of his youth—the son of “an Irish scrapper”—to the first two-term NDP premier in BC history. He meets his soulmate, Ellie, while drunkenly belting out songs on a university pub crawl. He attends a single talk by a tiny man he'd never heard of named Tommy Douglas and is changed overnight from a self-declared jock who was “just chipping away at what the world was all about” into a student of Canadian politics committed to helping lift whole communities out of struggle.

With characteristic frankness, Horgan leads readers through the pivotal moments of his political career—such as forging a remarkable alliance with the Greens and leading the NDP to its largest electoral victory in BC history. He also offers vivid accounts of his government's pressure-filled response to the COVID pandemic, his efforts to open new ways toward reconciliation with Indigenous peoples, and of facing the cancer that eventually ended his life. With each of these passages, a uniquely spirited personality comes into sharper focus, one who was always in search of a fragile balance between urgent environmental, labour and resource issues and whose memory and legacy will be essential to the province and the country in the challenging years ahead.

After years of service as MLA for Langford–Juan de Fuca and leader of the opposition, **JOHN HORGAN** was premier of British Columbia from 2017 to 2022. He retired from politics in 2023 and was appointed Canada's ambassador to Germany. He passed away the following year at the age of sixty-five.

**ROD MICKLEBURGH** is a former labour reporter for the *Vancouver Sun* and *Province* and a senior writer at *The Globe and Mail* for more than twenty years. He is also the co-author of *The Art of the Impossible: Dave Barrett and the NDP in Power, 1972–1975*. He worked closely with John Horgan to enable him to recount his life story. Mickleburgh lives in Vancouver, BC.

# Coastal Connections

## *A History of British Columbia Ferries and Passenger Ships*

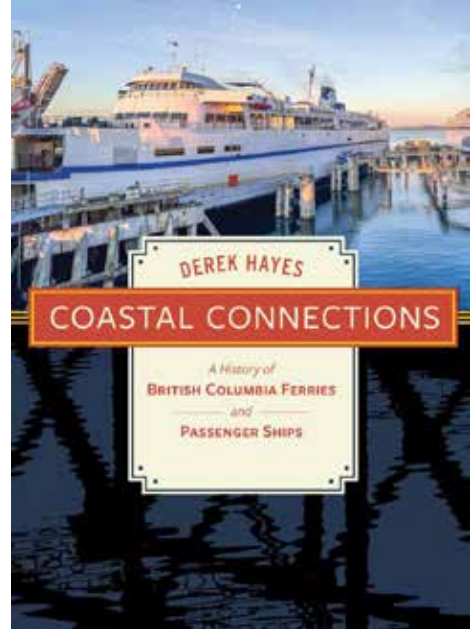
*Award-winning historian and photographer Derek Hayes examines the long and colourful history of ferries and ships linking the BC coast.*

FROM EARLY PADDLE-WHEELERS LIKE the *S.S. Beaver* to the latest high-speed catamaran, ferries and passenger vessels have always been central to the lives and livelihoods of British Columbians, connecting Vancouver Island, hundreds of smaller islands and a rugged mainland coastline to the rest of the province. This history culminated in the creation of BC Ferries, whose vessels today serve every part of coastal BC.

In *Coastal Connections*, historian Derek Hayes describes early attempts to provide links between the Mainland and Vancouver Island as well as the upper mainland coast. There was Canadian Pacific, with its fleet of Pacific Princesses; Canadian National, with its counterbalancing fleet of Prince ships serving the new city at the end of its northern line, Prince Rupert; and Union Steamships, which provided service to small BC Coast settlements for over 70 years. Then came BC Ferries. Starting in 1960 with just two ships, it has grown to become one of the world's largest ferry fleets, with 35 ships carrying over 22 million passengers and nearly 10 million vehicles a year over more than 25 routes.

Illustrated with hundreds of archival and modern photographs, artworks and ephemera, the book is a visual treat for anyone interested in the coastal history of British Columbia, the BC Ferries fleet and its operations.

**DEREK HAYES** is a renowned historian and the author of multiple books, including the bestselling *Historical Atlas of the Pacific Northwest*. Trained as a geographer at the University of Hull in England and the University of British Columbia, he worked for a time as a planner with the Vancouver City Planning Department and was also a columnist for *Fine Books & Collections* magazine for several years. He lives in White Rock, BC.

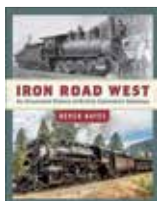

# Fishes of the Strait of Georgia

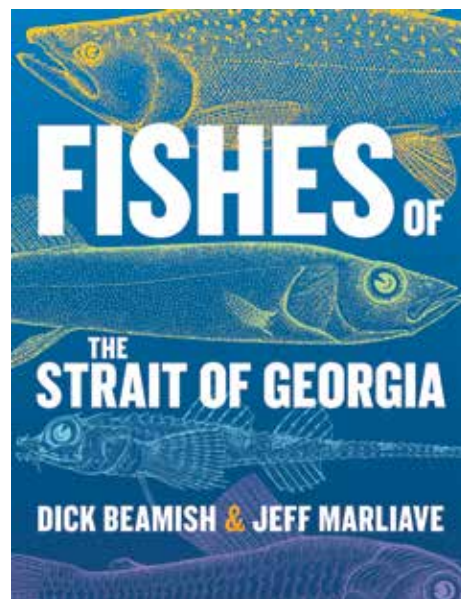
*This encyclopedic yet readable work from two of the greatest living experts on the subject is the most complete account ever published on the life histories of the astonishing array of fishes that live in, or pass through, the waters of the Strait of Georgia.*

THE STRAIT OF GEORGIA, British Columbia's magnificent inland sea, is one of the world's great fish habitats, home to over two hundred species ranging from the miniscule pencilsmelt to the gargantuan basking shark. Most of the three million British Columbians who live around the strait are aware of a mere handful of the most common fish—such as salmon, herring and rockfish—and know little about even those species, beyond how to catch and cook them. In this book they will learn about the remarkable life histories, the physical characteristics, the social and economic importance and the ecological place of not just the well-known fish but each of 243 incredibly diverse species that frequent the strait.

Fish scientists Dick Beamish and Jeff Marliave have spent their professional lives studying this bountiful natural aquarium and have created a reference that will inspire both the common and the scholarly reader. In the way it presents the life story of each fish, as well as its place in the larger story of the strait, there has never been a book like it. *Fishes of the Strait of Georgia* is an essential companion for all students of the sea, whether in the home, the classroom or the lab.

**DICK BEAMISH** has a PhD in Zoology from the University of Toronto and has worked for, and with, numerous research organizations. He has received the Order of Canada, the Order of British Columbia and is a Fellow of the Royal Society of Canada. He was also a member of the International Panel on Climate Change that received the Nobel Peace Prize in 2007. He lives on Vancouver Island, BC.

**JEFF MARLIAVE** has a PhD in Zoology from the University of British Columbia. He was resident scientist, then vp of Marine Science, at Vancouver Aquarium. He lives in North Vancouver, BC.

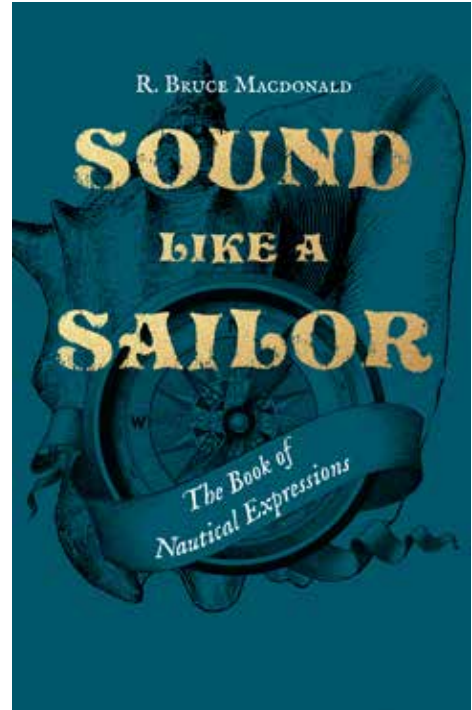

LIFELONG SAILOR BRUCE MACDONALD knows a thing or two about the language of the sea and, in *Sound Like a Sailor*, he catalogues nautical terms and idioms that are used in the common vernacular. Delving deep into the colourful history behind each word or phrase, this alphabetical reference will help readers understand the maritime origins of our most ubiquitous expressions.

Discover how minding your p's and q's originates in how bartenders kept track of pints and quarts on sailors' tabs, how "going berserk" calls up images of shirtless Vikings, and how the word "footloose" originally referred to an untethered sail flapping around like Kevin Bacon's legs. And, as any superstitious sailor knows, it's best to "cheat the devil" by having an arsenal of euphemisms at the ready when needed, as cursing is said to invite trouble aboard.

An essential book for boating enthusiasts and language buffs alike, *Sound Like a Sailor* is a windfall of fascinating linguistic information.

**R. BRUCE MACDONALD** is a writer, sailor and artist with a passion for Canadian history. Macdonald has logged over 100,000 nautical miles and, for many years, lived along the BC coast aboard *North Star* with his family. He is the author of *North Star of Herschel Island* (Friesen Press, 2012), *Sisters of the Ice* (2021) and *Never Say P\*g: The Book of Sailors' Superstitions* (2022).

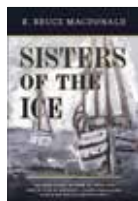

# Boom Times in Chilliwack

*Memories from the Post-war Years*

.....  
MERLIN BUNT

*What began as a steamboat landing on the Fraser River, in the traditional territory of the Stó:lō Nation, became a pioneer settlement in the 1860s. Today, Chilliwack is a thriving agricultural hub with a population in excess of 100,000. The more the city grows so too does local interest in its history, coupled with a move to preserve what is left of the community's past and its heritage.*

**BOOM TIMES IN CHILLIWACK** celebrates a dynamic time in the city's past when it experienced unprecedented growth. After World War II, with surging population growth and a steadily increasing tax base, came major infrastructure projects such as a new library and firehall, courthouse, arena, hospital and civic centre. The Paramount Theatre installed its iconic neon sign downtown in the spring of 1949, and a drive-in theatre on the edge of town opened the next summer. Meanwhile, the city's restaurant options, retail sector, schools and sporting scene all grew significantly.

These cultural and physical shifts—including fast-food drive-ins, subdivisions and a burgeoning consumer culture—represent in microcosm changes that were happening in communities across North America, but with a special local flavour. Accompanied by a wealth of archival photos, *Boom Times in Chilliwack* chronicles the entertaining tales that come with rapid change, and captures the developments and the economic optimism of the 1950s and 1960s that laid the groundwork for the Chilliwack of today.

**MERLIN BUNT** is a retired accountant and keen local historian. He was born in Chilliwack in the 1950s and is a fifth-generation Chilliwackian. Since 2014, he has posted more than 400 original articles on his popular Facebook history page, "Chilliwack History Perspectives," about aspects of Chilliwack's past. He has also authored articles appearing in *The Chilliwack Progress* newspaper and *The Northern Mariner* journal. Bunt serves as treasurer on the board of the Chilliwack Museum and Historical Society and is a member of the Heritage Chilliwack Society. He lives in Chilliwack, BC.

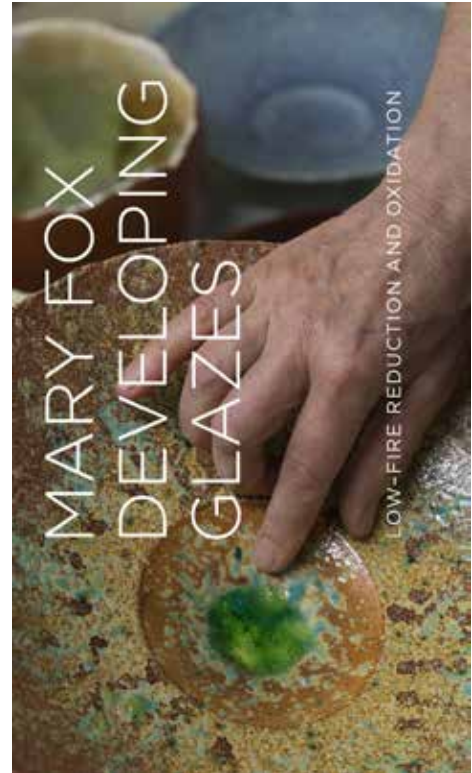
MANY POTTERS FIND THE glazing process difficult, if not downright intimidating. And with the prevalence of ready-made glazes, potters often overlook the exceptional results that can be achieved by experimenting with minerals and clay slips. Mary Fox takes readers on an exploration of unique glaze materials, providing step-by-step instructions and demonstrating how to bring a creative and adventurous attitude to the process.

All the glazes in this book are fired from cone 06 to 04. Low-temperature firing saves enormously on energy use, making the process more sustainable and cost-effective. Plus, the ingredients Fox uses in her low-fire recipes are readily available and most are inexpensive.

With *Developing Glazes*, potters can start approaching glazing in the same way they might develop a recipe in their kitchens, bringing in play, excitement and fun.

All royalties from the book will be donated to the endowment fund for the Legacy Project, which aims to develop young potters' careers through apprenticeships, residencies, affordable studio space and a library of videos documenting the sharing of techniques.

**MARY FOX** is a self-taught exploratory potter who has been working with clay since she was thirteen years old and as a professional potter for over forty years. Her innovative and inspired creations have garnered national and international acclaim. Fox creates contemporary pieces based on classic lines that express the beauty and strength of pure form. With inspired original glazes and shapes that seem to spring up from the earth, each of Fox's pieces tells its own story, evoking a sense of wonder and intensity that is both delicate and powerful. Fox's memoir, *My Life as a Potter* (2020), is a beautifully illustrated coffee table book celebrating the art of one of BC's finest potters. Fox lives and works in her studio located in Ladysmith on Vancouver Island, BC.

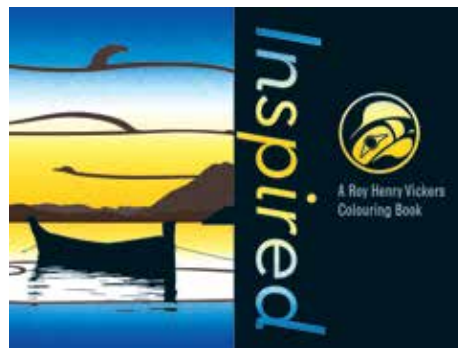

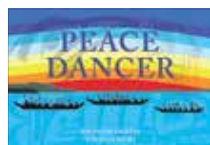

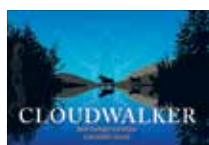

# The Time of Falling Apart

Poems

.....  
WENDY DONAWA

*In a voice that shifts from ironic and quirky to contemplative and speculative, The Time of Falling Apart follows the poet through the inevitable passage of memory and time, and a search for meaning in a world rife with injustice.*

WITHOUT A TRADITIONAL FAITH to navigate the horrors and wonders of life on earth, Wendy Donawa lingers with small beauties in a spiritual quest to keep love alive in a “darkening world.”

The speaker’s eyes are wide open on catastrophes of aging, illness and family strife. But early memories are idyllic, entangled in the tides and towns of Vancouver Island, grounded by the coast’s sensory world: “the tide’s pebbly click and shush / and crows cawing in the arbutus.”

As she ages, the speaker’s internal narrative expands to consider a wider world populated with casualties of colonizing desires, fuelled by competing ideologies and a destabilizing pandemic—the “time of falling apart.” Here are the social hells of racism, war, colonial violence and homelessness. Here are despair over a damaged earth and grief over nature’s destruction.

And yet, how not to notice when bees hum in the lavender, cyclamen gleams in December, and bears burrow in their marvellous, layered coats? When Bach blasts on the sound system, friends and cappuccinos are at hand, and, at the back of it all, there is always the unfathomable, glorious mystery of the cosmos.

Elegiac, meditative and unwaveringly kind, this collection is for anyone who has felt unable to reconcile the implacable passing of time, but determined to recognize love and beauty wherever they may be found.

**WENDY DONAWA** left her natal Victoria as a young woman to settle in Barbados. She attended the University of the West Indies, taught college literature and became a curator at the Barbados Museum. Decades later, she returned to Victoria to complete her Ph.D., taught literature for several years and turned her focus to her first love, poetry. Her poetry collection, *Thin Air of the Knowable* (Brick Books, 2017), was longlisted for the Raymond Souster Award and a finalist for the Gerald Lampert Award. Her second collection, *Our Bodies’ Unanswered Questions* (Frontenac House, 2021), launched with the Frontenac Quartet. *The Time of Falling Apart* is her third poetry collection. Her poems are published in *Arc Poetry Magazine*, *Prairie Fire*, *Freefall*, *The New Quarterly*, *The Literary Review of Canada*, *Room* and others. She is a contributing editor with *Arc Poetry Magazine* and a board member with Planet Earth Poetry reading series. She writes a monthly review, “Unpacking the Poem,” celebrating the diversity and creativity of BC poets. She and her wife live gratefully on the unceded territory of the lək̓ʷəŋən (Lekwungen-speaking) Esquimalt and Songhees people, in Victoria, BC.

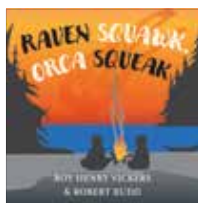

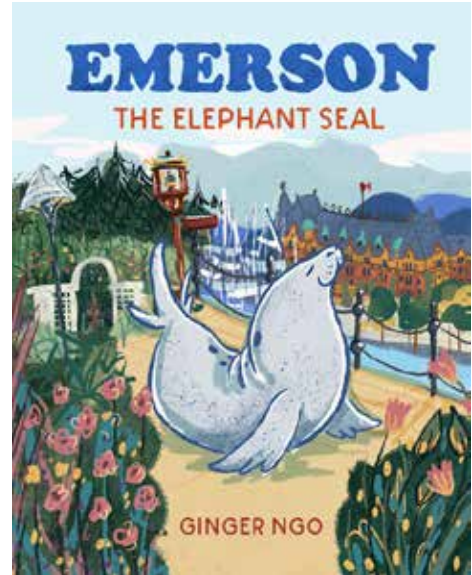

EMERSON, A TWO-YEAR-OLD JUVENILE elephant seal, keeps turning up in Victoria, BC, despite the best efforts of the Department of Fisheries and Oceans staff—who would like him to know that the provincial capital is not the best home for a 500-pound pinniped.

Born in January 2022 on Bowman Bay in Puget Sound, Emerson made headlines across Canada and gained a loyal following in Victoria, where he spent a month moulting at Oak Bay Marina Beach before making his way onto the grassy boulevard next to Beach Drive. Undeterred by several efforts to relocate him, Emerson returned again and again to Victoria's beaches and roads.

But what exactly brought Emerson back? In this energetic picture book, children will wonder: perhaps he longed to try the smoked salmon tea sandwiches at the Empress? Did Emerson want to roll all over the flowers at Butchart Gardens or take a tour of the BC Parliament Buildings? While wildlife officials have their theories, Ginger Ngo explores the capital through the eyes of Emerson in a way that will have Victoria's youngest residents and visitors laughing out loud.

**GINGER NGO** is a Canadian illustrator and graphic designer who loves working with thoughtful people and creative minds. She is a proud immigrant from the Pearl of the Orient Seas with lots of stories to tell. Born and raised in the Philippines, with Chinese roots and a third-culture childhood, Ginger grew up with Filipino music, English books, Mexican telenovelas, Japanese cartoons and Chinese banquets. In Canada, she learned about winters, camping, public libraries, David Suzuki and Gore-Tex. Ginger illustrated the funny, adventure-packed picture book by Grant Lawrence, *Adventures in Desolation Sound* (2024). She lives in Vancouver, BC.

# Most Grievous Fault

*A startling story of a young mother desperate to deny her complicity in intergenerational trauma.*

TWENTY-NINE-YEAR-OLD CRYSTAL CONSTANTINE IS a single parent who cannot see beyond the piles of bills, the threat of eviction, the weight of her past and the relentless needs of her teenage daughter Becky. How can she *not* drink? How can she *not* hit?

After fourteen-year-old Becky, who is suspected of having fetal alcohol syndrome, takes off her clothes for a group of boys at school, Crystal is pressured into sending her to a traditional Catholic school. Suddenly, the apartment echoes with bible verses and Hail Marys, and Crystal is dropped into a world of virtue and innocence completely foreign to all she's ever known. When Crystal meets Tim, a man of strict religious morals, she is equal parts afraid and elated. He interprets her frigidity as chastity, and Crystal sees no option but to deny that Becky, the result of rape, is her daughter. She sends Becky to live with her alcoholic grandmother, the same abusive, neglectful woman Crystal blames for her own troubles. Despite an acute ache for the well-being of her daughter, Crystal believes that, finally, happiness is within reach. She sees freedom, a wedding, a big house, money! But when Becky comes home distraught and uncommunicative, and arranges a secret and disastrous meeting with the man she believes is her father, Crystal is forced to acknowledge her own role in the perpetuation of trauma.

Through unflinching and unsentimental prose, Meg Todd delivers a story about being inescapably marginalized and the complexities of the social welfare system.

**MEG TODD** grew up in the Alberta prairies. She is a two-time finalist for the CBC short story prize, and her work has appeared in *Ploughshares*, *Prairie Fire*, *PRISM international* and elsewhere. Her debut short story collection, *Exit Strategies*, was a finalist for both the ReLit Award and the Danuta Gleed Literary Award. She holds an MFA in Creative Writing from University of British Columbia and a BA in Religious Studies from the University of Calgary. She lives on Vancouver Island.

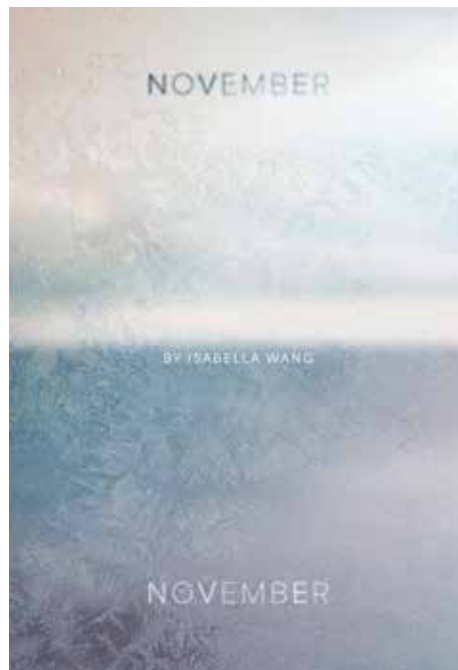

*Written across the span of four Novembers, this collection delivers a send-off to “loved poets” who are no longer with us.*

DEDICATED AS LETTERS AND long epistolary lyrics to those who are missing a loved one, *November, November* acknowledges poetry’s “palpitating vulnerable form,” and how sometimes a poem might be the only comfort that resides between silence and grief.

Isabella Wang’s second collection began as a tribute to the late Phyllis Webb, and was completed in the aftermath of Wang’s cancer diagnosis. The poems respond directly to Webb’s work and collapse the fine landscapes separating death and Wang’s own mortality. Over the course of treatment and “days [when] we don’t get to rewrite the history of our bodies,” the pace of Wang’s poetry slows down in the complicated recovery from cancer. Entering the cloudless silver of November days, her words tell a story of loss and illness, and her poems linger in the cold air, visible.

**ISABELLA WANG** is the author of *Pebble Swing* (Nightwood Editions, 2021), a finalist for the Dorothy Livesay Poetry Prize, and the chapbook *On Forgetting a Language* (Baseline Press, 2019). Among other recognitions, she has been shortlisted for Arc’s Poem of the Year Contest, *The Malahat Review*’s Far Horizons Award and Long Poem Contest, *Minola Review*’s Inaugural Poetry Contest, and was the youngest writer to be shortlisted twice for *The New Quarterly*’s Edna Staebler Personal Essay Contest. Wang’s poetry and prose have appeared in over thirty literary journals and five anthologies, most recently *The Spirits Have Nothing to Do with Us* (Wolsak and Wynn, 2022). She collaborates with *poetry in canada*, and directs her own non-profit editing and mentorship program, Revise-Revision Street. She lives in New Westminster, BC.

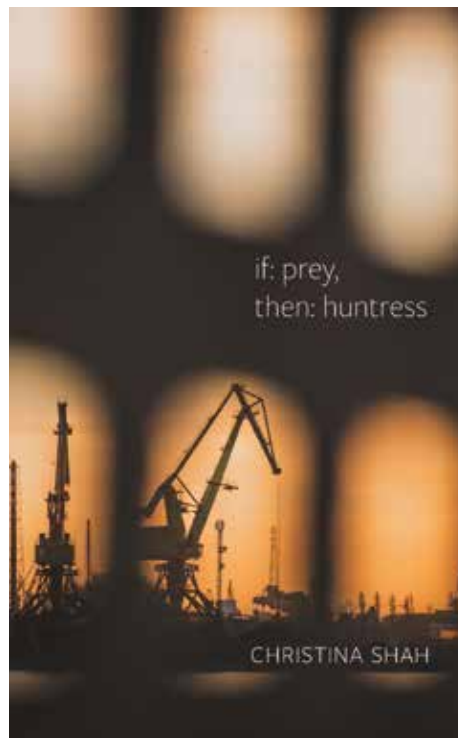
CHRISTINA SHAH

*In her much-anticipated debut collection, Christina Shah captures the landscape of heavy industry in Canada through the perceptive eyes of a poet.*

FROM A POET WORKING in heavy industry comes an eclectic collection of observations and experiences as a woman on the road and out in the field in traditionally male-dominated environments. *if: prey, then: huntress* is an exploration of vulnerability, agency and existential homelessness, replete with portraits of beer drinkers and hellraisers and urban landscapes. These poems illuminate the beauty and truth amid the concrete, twisted metal and scraped knuckles.

At a time when Western Canada is reimagining its resource-based economy, Shah's poems position her as a wandering eulogist for old industrial ways of knowing—and for their greying practitioners in the mines, paper mills, shipyards and scrapyards that undergird modern life. The reader is invited into a world that, like the breath, is both dying and being born every minute.

**CHRISTINA SHAH** lives in Vancouver and works in heavy industry, where she drinks from the firehose of knowledge. Her poetry has appeared numerous Canadian literary journals, including *The Fiddlehead*, *Vallum*, *Arc*, *Grain*, *PRISM international*, *EVENT*, *The Malahat Review*, *The Antigonish Review* and elsewhere. Her poem "they canned a good man today" was shortlisted for *The Fiddlehead*'s 2021 Ralph Gustafson Poetry Prize. Her poem "interior bar, 1986" was selected for *Best Canadian Poetry 2023*. She is one-fifth of the Harbour Centre 5 poetry collective, whose chapbook *Brine* was released in 2022. Her first videopoem "rig veda" (in collaboration with videographer Mark Mushet) was translated into Spanish and screened at the 2023 Cinemística festival in Granada, Spain, and the 2023 Versi Di Luce festival in Modica, Sicily. *rig veda*, her first solo chapbook (Anstruther Press), was released in 2023. She has some strong opinions on soft pretzels.

## The Teachings of Mutton

*A Coast Salish Woolly Dog*

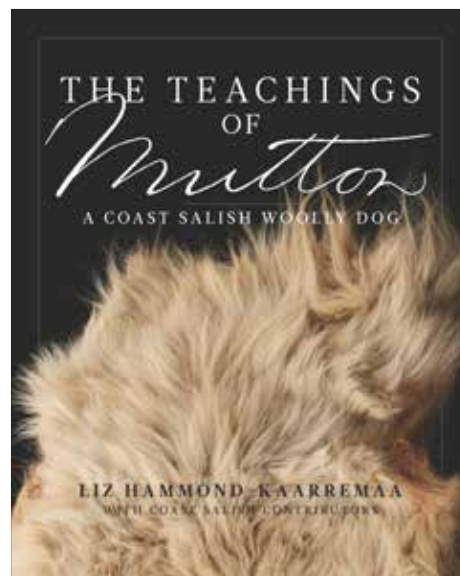

UNTIL NOW, THERE has been very little written about the enigmatic Coast Salish Woolly Dog, or *sq'əməy* in the Hul'q'umi'num language. According to Indigenous Oral Histories of the Pacific Northwest, this small dog was bred for thousands of years for its woolly fibres, which were woven into traditional blankets, robes and regalia. Although the dogs were carefully protected by Coast Salish peoples, by the 1900s, the Woolly Dog had become so rare it is now considered extinct.

Co-authored with weavers, Knowledge Keepers, and Elders, *The Teachings of Mutton* interweaves perspectives from Musqueam, Squamish, Stó:lō, Suquamish, Cowichan, Katzie, Snuneymuxw, and Skokomish cultures with narratives of science, post-contact history, and the lasting and devastating impacts of colonization. Binding it all together is Mutton's story—a tale of research, reawakening, and resurgence.

## Raincoast Chronicles 25

*mamata Goes Fishing*

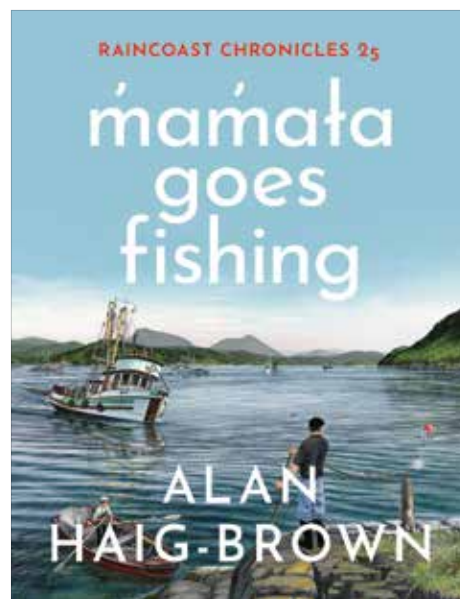

IN *RAINCOAST CHRONICLES 25*, Haig-Brown recounts his formative years as a deckhand in the 1960s and early '70s on a fishing boat run by the We Wai Kai family he married into as a teenager. The history of commercial fishing and of British Columbia itself, in all its twisting relations with Indigenous peoples, is mirrored in Haig-Brown's vivid account of life aboard, where "there are no typical days" despite the tightly choreographed tasks and immense local knowledge required by this ever-risky business.

Recalling dancing fingers deftly untangling purse seine nets, the delicious salmon stews and huckleberry pies Mitzi Assu whipped up from a cramped galley, and the crew's navigation skills in facing dangerous tide rips, Haig-Brown beautifully captures the daily rhythms, challenges, and camaraderie of life on the fishing boat from a decade spent immersed in the traditions of the We Wai Kai people under the remarkable skipper Herb Assu. It was the Assu family that gave Haig-Brown the experience that has led him to understand the harmony and sustainability of the traditional Indigenous approach to the environment.

Now an experienced international marine journalist, Haig-Brown adds historical context to the narrative, providing a nuanced view of the interplay between Indigenous communities and the commercial fishing industry. Illustrated with black and white photographs, mostly by Vicki Assu, his wife at the time, this account not only portrays a young man's journey but also serves as a tribute to the enduring spirit and resilience of the We Wai Kai family and their deep connection to the coastal waters of British Columbia.

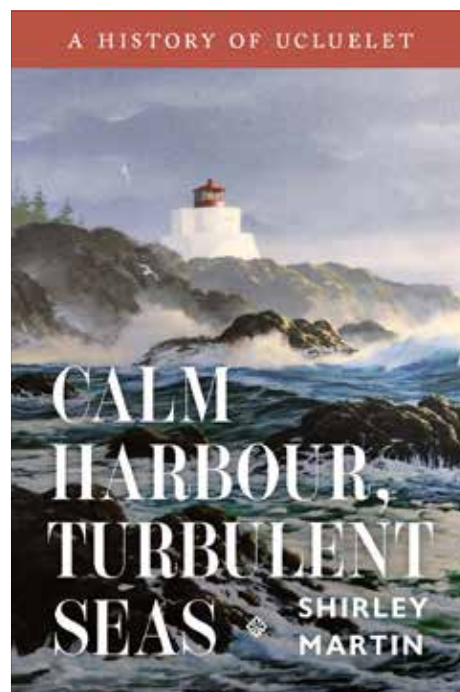
ONCE AN ISOLATED outpost, now a touted tourist destination, Ucluelet sits at the gateway to Barkley Sound, epitomising “life on the edge.”

The history of Ucluelet begins with stories shared by local Yuułuʔiłʔatḥ (Ucluelet) and tükʷaaʔatḥ (Toquaht) people about life before European contact. The arrival of fur traders, whalers and missionaries brought cataclysmic changes and compelling personal stories of the settlers and the pre-emptionists who followed. Drama abounds in the depiction of shipwrecks, lifeboat rescues and the building of the iconic Amphitrite Point Lighthouse. Martin describes the ships that were once a lifeline to the outside world, and details the struggle for the long-awaited road.

Chapters on mining, fishing and logging demonstrate Ucluelet’s roots as a resource-based town and examine the profound changes brought about by the “War in the Woods.” With the turnaround from resource-based employment, Ucluelet shifted into tourism.

*Calm Harbour, Turbulent Seas* captures the essence of Ucluelet, including an account of the still-thriving art scene, and concludes with a look at the present-day community—what has changed and what remains the same.

THE 1960S WERE famously a decade of cultural revolution, and Simon Fraser University was a creature of its time. The counter-culture spirit infected all levels of society, but none more than the new university and its innovative arts programming. Early SFU was shaped by a vision of a new kind of university where thought was free-flowing and lines between the disciplines were blurred. The open format attracted experimental artists such as the dramatist John Juliani and the composer R. Murray Schaffer, whose avant-garde performances did much to set a revolutionary tone. In this multi-authored book, writers associated with the university such as Max Wyman, Barry Truax, Ann Cowan and Francis Mansbridge capture the excitement of that first decade of the arts at SFU. Hildegard Westercamp, Carole Gerson and Christine Hearn describe the years of ferment from the viewpoint of former SFU students, and celebrated filmmaker Sandy Wilson contributes a moving piece written specifically for this book about the beginning of her career in film as a student at SFU. Richly illustrated with ephemera and photographs from the era, *A Magical Time* traces how innovation in the arts shaped events over the next six decades at SFU.

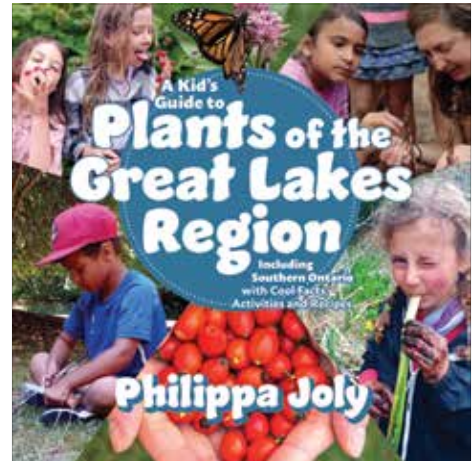

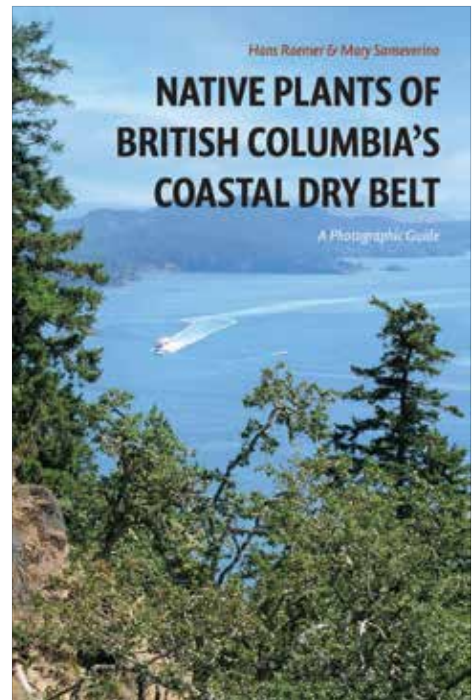

The poems of Tom Wayman's new collection, *Out of the Ordinary*, explore how such extraordinary developments can both arise from, and affect, the ordinary objects, environments and human relationships that surround us. To probe this traffic between the ordinary and the extraordinary, the poems of *Out of the Ordinary* go deep, drawing on poetry's almost-magical ability to discover links between aspects of our lives that otherwise seem far apart. The sections of this collection investigate some responses to this century's quandaries, the enduring mysteriousness of nature as well as of our historic and cultural worlds, and what we find if we imaginatively enter a carrot seed or a raindrop. 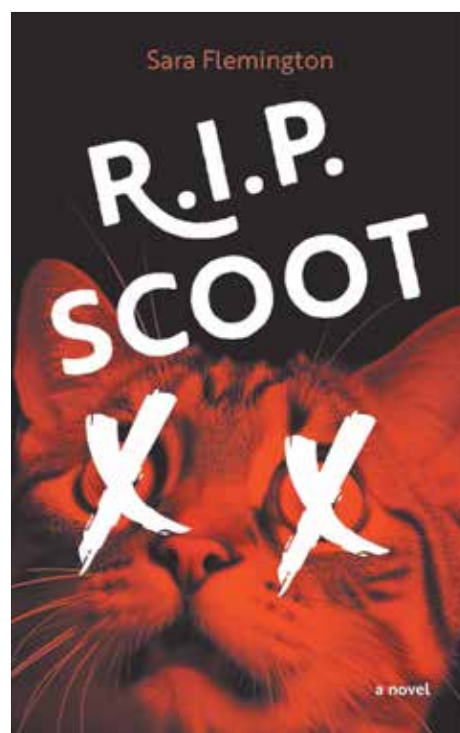
## RIP Scoot

TWENTYSOMETHING AUSTIN LIVES alone in a crumbling office-turned-studio apartment of a former mops, brushes and brooms factory in Toronto. After a deformed and lice-ridden cat turns up at his door, then abruptly dies three weeks later, Austin begins to find frightening coincidences connecting him to a squatter living in his local Walmart, a botanical garden in Missouri, a shipping route from Greece, a muralist in Japan, the world of an online dystopia and more. As the obsession with piecing together the mystery surrounding his dead pet, and the reward the cat is potentially worth, takes over, Austin confronts his financial and family issues, his self-imposed isolation and his abandoned sense of direction. He discovers what purpose this mystery might actually serve in helping him cope with, and potentially recover, all that he’s really lost.

In the end, *RIP Scoot* is as much a story about an anomalous dead cat as it is a rich, conscientious depiction of grief, complicated relationships and the choices that occur when fighting change is no longer an option.

THE POEMS IN *Existing Music* both celebrate and interrogate the idea of the “sad song.” The lyrical narrative mixes autobiographical poems with fantasies about the speaker’s favourite musicians—from the long gaps between one artist’s records, and grief over another’s suicide, to the marvelling at another’s ability to write “beautiful songs about potatoes.” The long poem “The Minim” considers the sad song from the point of view of an amateur musician at practice, using language that riffs upon an existing dictionary of musical terms with an eye towards making “vigorous chambers, frivolous rooms.” Lastly, the collection considers the sad song as a collaboration within communities: whether at the bookstore, within a family or between two poets who write in different languages.

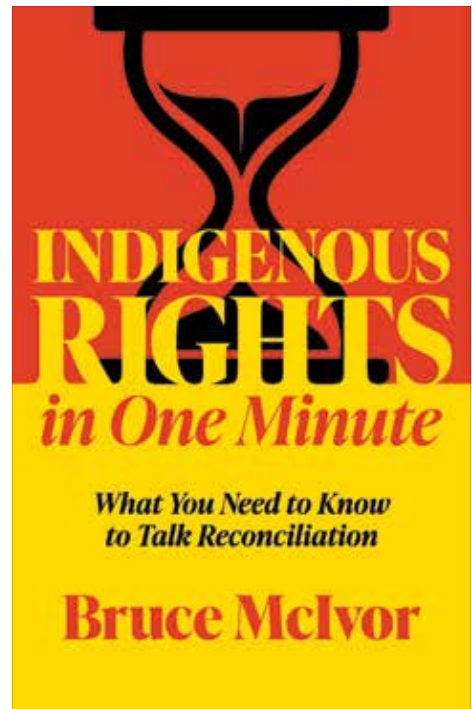

To ensure the country’s reconciliation project progresses from rhetoric to reality, ordinary Canadians need straightforward answers to fundamental questions. McIvor provides the answers and context to support a thoughtful and respectful national conversation about reconciliation and the fulfillment of Canada’s commitment to a better future for Indigenous people.
