But since the 1970s, health and environmental concerns have led to a re-evaluation of natural dyes and their use in the textile industry. A number of insects can be used to produce natural dyes and pigments. Research, harvesting and processing these insects to create dye solutions has been a long and often challenging process for designers and makers who wish to use natural dyes.

In the 1990s, a new method of harvesting insects was developed, which involved using a vacuum to suck up insects from a large area. This method is now widely used by designers and makers who wish to use natural dyes.
