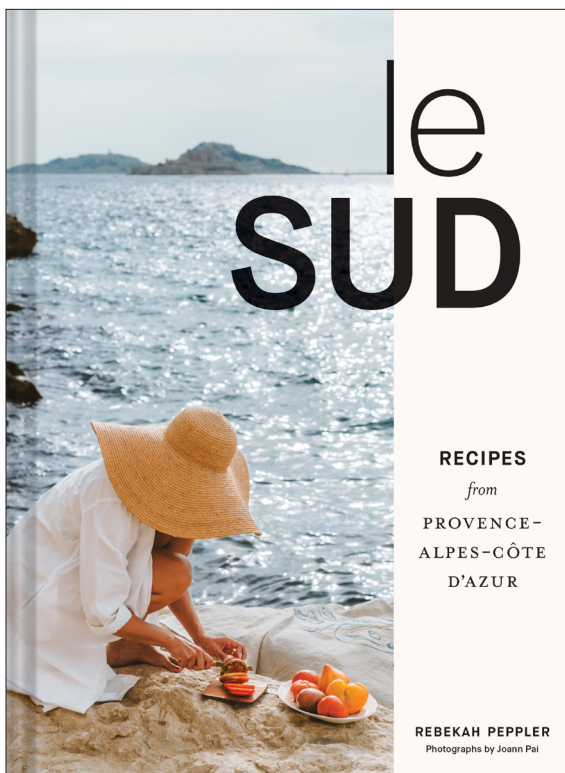

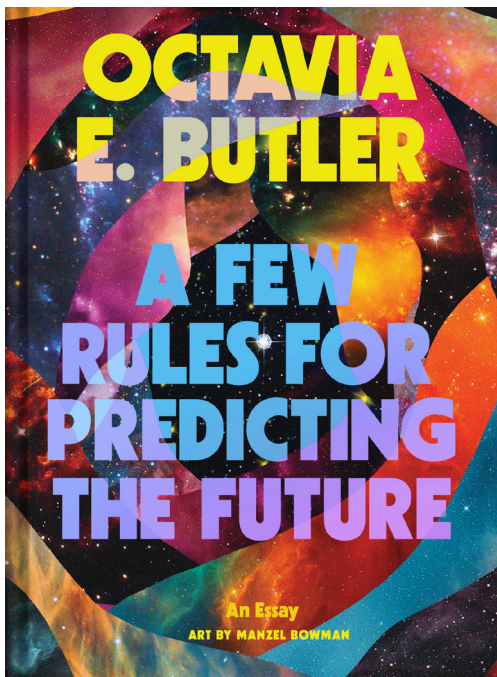

She received a MacArthur Genius Grant and PEN West Lifetime Achievement Award for her body of work and was acclaimed for her lean prose, strong protagonists, and social observations in stories that range from the distant past to the far future.

¼ cup (3 g) cilantro leaves

3 oz (90 ml) tequila
3 oz (90 ml) cucumber juice (see Note)
Cilantro sprigs, for garnish

In a cocktail shaker, combine the lemon juice, agave, and cilantro leaves. Muddle until you extract as much of the oils as possible. Add the tequila, cucumber juice, and a handful of ice to the shaker. Shake until well-chilled, about 30 seconds. Strain into two rocks glasses over ice. Garnish each with a cilantro sprig.

Note: To make cucumber juice, add 1 cup (135 g) of peeled and sliced cucumber and 1 oz (29.6 ml) of water to a blender. Blend until pulsed. Strain through a fine-mesh strainer.

If you're feeling spicy, kick this cocktail up a notch with 5 to 10 drops of Dippin' Onions Liquid Heat.

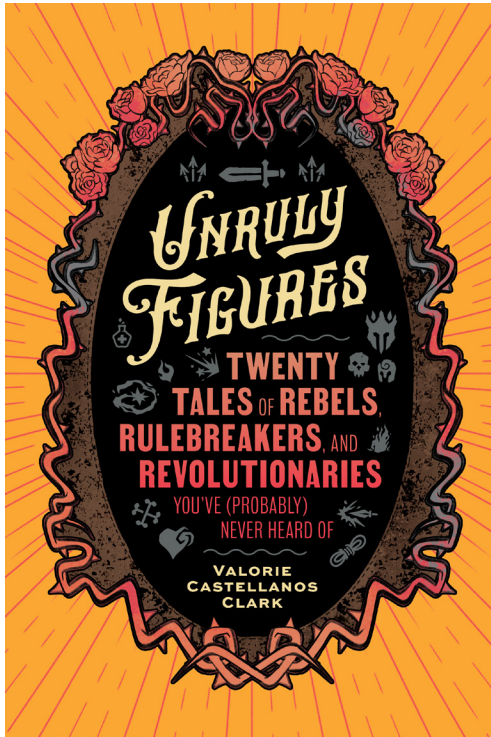
THE SHOULDSTORM DEFINED
