

With a foreword by pickle pioneer Sandor Katz and an astonishing wealth of photographs, historical images, documents, illustrations, advertisements, and more.







- Finn, Pam's rabbit, helped her redefine the meaning of family while providing companionship and support living in a big city far from home.

With these honest, pure retellings, as well as her own stories, Willett reveals the mutual bond that grows when animals are invited into our sphere and how meaningful those relationships can be.






Celebrate the allure and variety of crustaceans with this beautifully illustrated guide to thirty species of crabs, lobsters, hermit crabs, and shrimps.


- Observed on the beach or among the rocks, they constitute a diverse and fascinating slice of marine life.

The first half of the book contains gorgeously detailed and realistic illustrations and delves into the species' main characteristics and the secrets of their underwater world. The second half features specimen cards with scientific information and fun facts for easy reference.









Joan Maloof is Professor Emeritus of Biology at Salisbury University, Maryland, and founder of the Old-Growth Forest Network, which is working to create a national network of protected old-growth woodlands. Her work has been featured in the *New York Times* and *Washington Post*, and she is the recipient of such prizes as the 2014 Mary Byrd Davis Award. She is the author of *Treepedia*, *Nature's Temples*, *The Living Forest*, *Teaching the Trees*, and *Among the Ancients*.

Sara Nunan is an artist and illustrator from the UK. She works from a small studio in the heart of Dartmoor National Park, whose stunning landscapes and abundant wildlife inspire her paintings.
