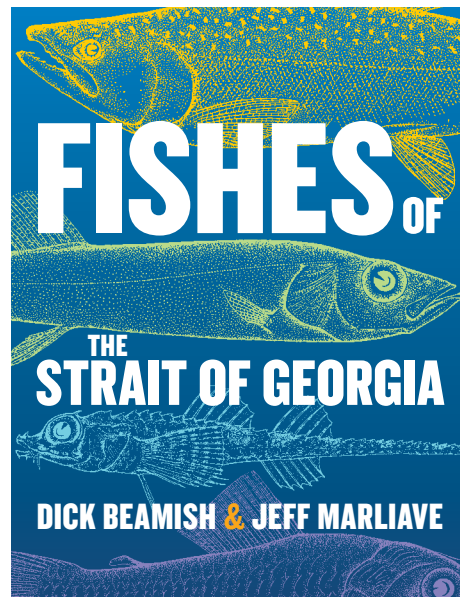
This encyclopedic yet readable work from two of the greatest living experts on the subject is the most complete account ever published on the life histories of the astonishing array of fishes that live in, or pass through, the waters of the Strait of Georgia.

THE STRAIT OF GEORGIA, British Columbia's magnificent inland sea, is one of the world's great fish habitats, home to over two hundred species ranging from the miniscule pencilsmelt to the gargantuan basking shark. Most of the three million British Columbians who live around the strait are aware of a mere handful of the most common fish—such as salmon, herring and rockfish—and know little about even those species, beyond how to catch and cook them. In this book they will learn about the remarkable life histories, the physical characteristics, the social and economic importance and the ecological place of not just the well-known fish but each of 243 incredibly diverse species that frequent the strait.

Fish scientists Dick Beamish and Jeff Marliave have spent their professional lives studying this bountiful natural aquarium and have created a reference that will inspire both the common and the scholarly reader. In the way it presents the life story of each fish, as well as its place in the larger story of the strait, there has never been a book like it. *Fishes of the Strait of Georgia* is an essential companion for all students of the sea, whether in the home, the classroom or the lab.

DICK BEAMISH has a PhD in Zoology from the University of Toronto and has worked for, and with, numerous research organizations. He has received the Order of Canada, the Order of British Columbia and is a Fellow of the Royal Society of Canada. He was also a member of the International Panel on Climate Change that received the Nobel Peace Prize in 2007. He lives on Vancouver Island, BC.

JEFF MARLIAVE has a PhD in Zoology from the University of British Columbia. He was resident scientist, then the vp of Marine Science, at Vancouver Aquarium. He lives in North Vancouver, BC.

The Teachings of Mutton

A Coast Salish Woolly Dog

LIZ HAMMOND-KAARREMAA, WITH COAST SALISH CONTRIBUTORS

The pelt of a dog named “Mutton” languished in a drawer at the Smithsonian for 150 years until it was discovered, almost accidentally, by an amateur archivist. This book tells Mutton’s story and explores what it can teach us about Coast Salish Woolly Dogs and their cultural significance.

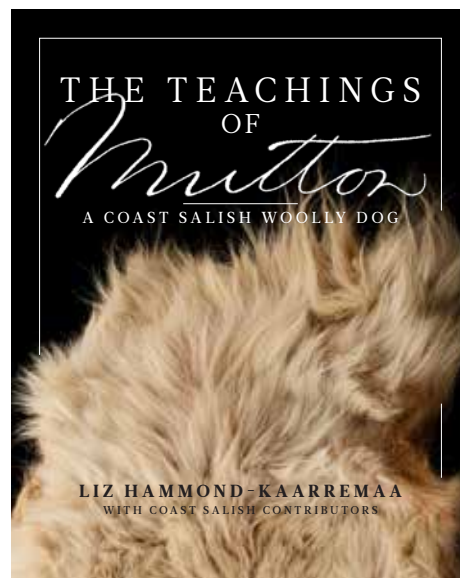
UNTIL NOW, THERE HAS been very little written about the enigmatic Coast Salish Woolly Dog, or *sq̓wəməy* in the Hul’q’umi’num language. According to Indigenous Oral Histories of the Pacific Northwest, this small dog was bred for thousands of years for its woolly fibres, which were woven into traditional blankets, robes and regalia. Although the dogs were carefully protected by Coast Salish peoples, by the 1900s, the Woolly Dog had become so rare it is now considered extinct.

Co-authored with weavers, Knowledge Keepers, and Elders, *The Teachings of Mutton* interweaves perspectives from Musqueam, Squamish, Stó:lō, Suquamish, Cowichan, Katzie, Snuneymuxw, and Skokomish cultures with narratives of science, post-contact history, and the lasting and devastating impacts of colonization. Binding it all together is Mutton’s story—a tale of research, reawakening, and resurgence.

LIZ HAMMOND-KAARREMAA has a MA in educational technology and holds a Master Spinner Certificate from Olds College. She is a researcher of Coast Salish spinning and collaborates with museums and Indigenous communities, sharing her knowledge through research writing, workshops and lectures. Her research and publications focus on Coast Salish textiles, including articles in academic journals (*Science, BC Studies*) and magazines (*Spin-Off, Ply, Selvedge*). She lives on Protection Island, near Nanaimo, BC.

mamala Goes Fishing

ALAN HAIG-BROWN

This 25th edition of Raincoast Chronicles intertwines Alan Haig-Brown's experiences of his formative years as a deckhand on a We Wai Kai seiner with the historical and cultural context of BC's commercial fishing industry.

IN *RAINCOAST CHRONICLES 25*, Haig-Brown recounts his formative years as a deckhand in the 1960s and early '70s on a fishing boat run by the We Wai Kai family he married into as a teenager. The history of commercial fishing and of British Columbia itself, in all its twisting relations with Indigenous peoples, is mirrored in Haig-Brown's vivid account of life aboard, where "there are no typical days" despite the tightly choreographed tasks and immense local knowledge required by this ever-risky business.

Recalling dancing fingers deftly untangling purse seine nets, the delicious salmon stews and huckleberry pies Mitzi Assu whipped up from a cramped galley, and the crew's navigation skills in facing dangerous tide rips, Haig-Brown beautifully captures the daily rhythms, challenges, and camaraderie of life on the fishing boat from a decade spent immersed in the traditions of the We Wai Kai people under the remarkable skipper Herb Assu. It was the Assu family that gave Haig-Brown the experience that has led him to understand the harmony and sustainability of the traditional Indigenous approach to the environment.

Now an experienced international marine journalist, Haig-Brown adds historical context to the narrative, providing a nuanced view of the interplay between Indigenous communities and the commercial fishing industry. Illustrated with black and white photographs, mostly by Vicki Assu, his wife at the time, this account not only portrays a young man's journey but also serves as a tribute to the enduring spirit and resilience of the We Wai Kai family and their deep connection to the coastal waters of British Columbia.

ALAN HAIG-BROWN learned to swim in the 1950s, among the humpback salmon in the Campbell River. He seined salmon and herring until 1973, and served for eleven years as coordinator of Indigenous education in the Cariboo-Chilcotin. Haig-Brown became editor of the *West Coast Fisherman* in 1986 and later founded *The West Coast Mariner* and *The West Coast Logger*. His award-winning books for Harbour Publishing include *Fishing for a Living* and *The Fraser River*. He lives in New Westminster, BC, and Bangkok, Thailand.

A History of Ucluelet

Shirley Martin weaves accounts of shipwrecks and sea serpents, settlement and dispossession, tragedy and resilience, unsolved mysteries and surprising revelations to depict the rich and vibrant history of Ucluelet and surrounding area.

ONCE AN ISOLATED OUTPOST, now a touted tourist destination, Ucluelet sits at the gateway to Barkley Sound, epitomising “life on the edge.”

The history of Ucluelet begins with stories shared by local Yuulu?il?ath (Ucluelet) and tuk^waa?ath (Toquaht) people about life before European contact. The arrival of fur traders, whalers and missionaries brought cataclysmic changes and compelling personal stories of the settlers and the pre-emptionists who followed. Drama abounds in the depiction of shipwrecks, lifeboat rescues and the building of the iconic Amphitrite Point Lighthouse. Martin describes the ships that were once a lifeline to the outside world, and details the struggle for the long-awaited road.

Chapters on mining, fishing and logging demonstrate Ucluelet’s roots as a resource-based town and examine the profound changes brought about by the “War in the Woods.” With the turnaround from resource-based employment, Ucluelet shifted into tourism.

Calm Harbour, Turbulent Seas captures the essence of Ucluelet, including an account of the still-thriving art scene, and concludes with a look at the present-day community—what has changed and what remains the same.

SHIRLEY MARTIN is a member of the Writers’ Union of Canada and the Federation of BC Writers. A lifelong resident of Ucluelet, she draws on her deep connections to local history and is a longtime director of the Ucluelet and Area Historical Society. She was the author of “Shoreline Column,” a regular feature in the *Tofino-Ucluelet Westerly News*, and several books, including *A is for Amphitrite: A Walk on Ucluelet’s Wild Pacific Trail*. She is also a passionate public speaker, and is often asked to present her insights into the region’s rich past.

A Magical Time

The Early Days of the Arts at Simon Fraser University

Simon Fraser University went from an idea in 1963 to opening its doors in 1965, a feat that led it to be dubbed “the instant university.” This multi-authored history chronicles the excitement of that first radical decade of the arts at SFU.

THE 1960S WERE FAMOUSLY a decade of cultural revolution, and Simon Fraser University was a creature of its time. The counter-culture spirit infected all levels of society, but none more than the new university and its innovative arts programming. Early SFU was shaped by a vision of a new kind of university where thought was free-flowing and lines between the disciplines were blurred. The open format attracted experimental artists such as the dramatist John Juliani and the composer R. Murray Schaffer, whose avant-garde performances did much to set a revolutionary tone. In this multi-authored book, writers associated with the university such as Max Wyman, Barry Truax, Ann Cowan and Francis Mansbridge capture the excitement of that first decade of the arts at SFU. Hildegard Westercamp, Carole Gerson and Christine Hearn describe the years of ferment from the viewpoint of former SFU students, and celebrated filmmaker Sandy Wilson contributes a moving piece written specifically for this book about the beginning of her career in film as a student at SFU. Richly illustrated with ephemera and photographs from the era, *A Magical Time* traces how innovation in the arts shaped events over the next six decades at SFU.

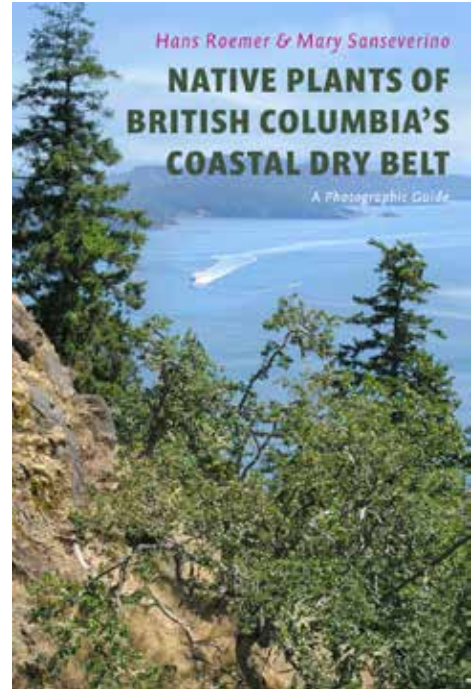

Her first book, *A Kid's Guide to Plants of the Pacific Northwest*, won a Silver Medal in the Moonbeam Children's Book Awards (2023) and was long-listed for the AAAS/Subaru SB&F Prize for Excellence in Science Books (2024). Joly lives on Denman Island, BC, with her plant-savvy daughter, Breah.

MAGGIE ZITO IS BEING held for murder. The volatile single mother is accused of killing the retired leader of the notorious Exiles motorcycle gang and his wife aboard their million-dollar houseboat. With a mystery witness putting Maggie at the scene, and the Exiles baying for her blood, it's unlikely she'll make it to the trial alive.

Desperate, Maggie's lawyer, Shuzhen Chen, calls in a favour to Dave Wakeland: Find evidence of Maggie's innocence and get her client out of custody.

Wakeland reluctantly returns to a changing city, full of unfamiliar dangers. To prove Maggie's innocence, he and Shuzhen must reckon with the Exiles crime syndicate and their bloodthirsty leader. The bikers are on the verge of a civil war, and an unseen foe is gunning for the top spot.

Dave and Shuzhen have to put aside their complicated past to learn the identity of the witness, and find out why Maggie was framed for this killing. To complicate matters, Wakeland's business partner is nowhere to be found. The security firm they started teeters on the verge of bankruptcy. Even if the case can be solved, and the business saved, can the partners ever trust each other?

SAM WIEBE is the author of the bestselling *Ocean Drive* (2024), as well as the Wakeland novels, one of the most authentic and acclaimed detective series in Canada, including *Sunset and Jericho* (2023) and *Hell and Gone* (2021). His work has won the Crime Writers of Canada award, the Kobo Emerging Writers prize, and a silver medal from the Independent Publisher Book Awards, and been shortlisted for the Edgar, Hammett, Shamus and City of Vancouver book prizes. 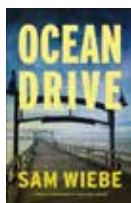

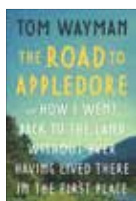
Wayman crafts poetry that captures how the everyday can contain the extraordinary.

THE TWENTY-FIRST CENTURY so far feels extraordinary, offering in its first quarter a global pandemic, catastrophic climate events, an unprecedented gap between the super-rich and the rest of us, new shortages in medical services and affordable homes, and more. The poems of Tom Wayman's new collection, *Out of the Ordinary*, explore how such extraordinary developments can both arise from, and affect, the ordinary objects, environments and human relationships that surround us.

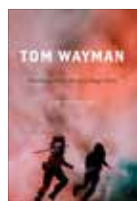
To probe this traffic between the ordinary and the extraordinary, the poems of *Out of the Ordinary* go deep, drawing on poetry's almost-magical ability to discover links between aspects of our lives that otherwise seem far apart. The sections of this collection investigate some responses to this century's quandaries, the enduring mysteriousness of nature as well as of our historic and cultural worlds, and what we find if we imaginatively enter a carrot seed or a raindrop. Other sections honour a friend lost during the pandemic, struggle with how to deal with such life-altering transitions, and marvel at the strangeness of this century's literary milieu. "Poets are the janitors of the human heart," Wayman maintains in a poem of that name, and he indeed demonstrates how poetry can make the ordinary shine brightly even in these turbulent decades.

TOM WAYMAN's prolific literary career includes writing more than twenty poetry collections, three collections of critical and cultural essays, three books of short fiction and a novel, as well as editing six poetry anthologies. He received British Columbia's 2022 George Woodcock Award for Lifetime Achievement in the literary arts. In 2015, he was named a Vancouver Literary Landmark, with a plaque on the city's Commercial Drive commemorating his championing of people writing for themselves about their daily employment. He won the Western Canada Jewish Book Awards prize for fiction in 2016 (for the short story collection, *The Shadows We Mistake for Love*) and for poetry in 2023 (for *Watching a Man Break a Dog's Back: Poems for a Dark Time*). His memoir, *The Road to Appledore (or How I Went Back to The Land Without Ever Having Lived There in the First Place)*, was published in 2024. Wayman lives in Winlaw, BC, and his website is www.tomwayman.com.

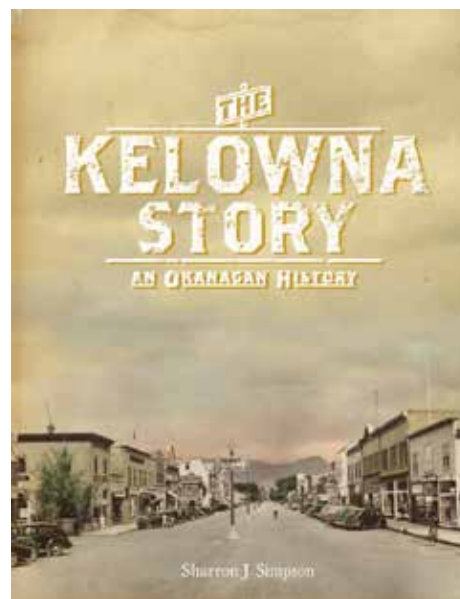
The new paperback edition of this excellent illustrated history includes additional information about recent developments up to 2025.

THE KELOWNA STORY is a comprehensive full-length history of the largest metropolitan centre outside BC's Lower Mainland, a labour of love by a leading local historian whose family roots have been entwined with Kelowna's for five generations. It embraces the full sweep of central Okanagan history, starting with the days of the S-Ookanhkchinx, who enjoyed a largely peaceful existence along the shores of the lakes and rivers before the earliest explorers came to trade, followed by Father Pandosy and his Okanagan Mission in 1859. It was the mission that attracted Kelowna's first homesteaders, soon followed by cattle ranchers and orchardists, and much later by the empire-builders like the Bennett family who paved the way for today's budding metropolis.

Author Sharron J. Simpson believes "history is best told through the stories of ordinary people," while allowing today's readers may not think it 'ordinary' to walk over mountain ranges to collect mail, or consider it 'ordinary' to climb into a narrow irrigation pipe to scrape the rust off the inside as it runs up and down the hillsides, or to row freight from one end of Okanagan Lake to the other. "In their time," she writes, "those who did extraordinary things were simply doing what needed to be done to get ahead. Their stories are fascinating and tell of the remarkable investment early settlers made in this community."

Simpson tells the story of her hometown with an attention to detail and a passion for narrative that bespeaks her own considerable talent and deep commitment.

SHARRON J. SIMPSON is a historian and former city councillor, and a passionate advocate for preserving community and family stories. Simpson has published numerous articles and local histories, including *Kelowna General Hospital: The First 100 Years, 1908-2008* and *Boards, Boxes and Bins: Stanley M. Simpson and the Okanagan Lumber Industry*. She lives in Kelowna, BC.

Dashiell Hammett's Red Harvest and Mark Haddon's The Curious Incident of the Dog in the Night-Time meet The Big Lebowski in this literary mystery that asks us to examine what stories, real or fiction, become the metaphors we use for working through our own challenges and uncertainties.

TWENTYSOMETHING AUSTIN LIVES ALONE in a crumbling office-turned-studio apartment of a former mops, brushes and brooms factory in Toronto. After a deformed and lice-ridden cat turns up at his door, then abruptly dies three weeks later, Austin begins to find frightening coincidences connecting him to a squatter living in his local Walmart, a botanical garden in Missouri, a shipping route from Greece, a muralist in Japan, the world of an online dystopia and more. As the obsession with piecing together the mystery surrounding his dead pet, and the reward the cat is potentially worth, takes over, Austin confronts his financial and family issues, his self-imposed isolation and his abandoned sense of direction. He discovers what purpose this mystery might actually serve in helping him cope with, and potentially recover, all that he's really lost.

In the end, *RIP Scoot* is as much a story about an anomalous dead cat as it is a rich, conscientious depiction of grief, complicated relationships and the choices that occur when fighting change is no longer an option.

Trillium Book Award-winner Nick Thran explores the companionship of wistful music in his fourth collection.

THE POEMS IN *EXISTING MUSIC* both celebrate and interrogate the idea of the “sad song.” The lyrical narrative mixes autobiographical poems with fantasies about the speaker’s favourite musicians—from the long gaps between one artist’s records, and grief over another’s suicide, to the marvelling at another’s ability to write “beautiful songs about potatoes.” The long poem “The Minim” considers the sad song from the point of view of an amateur musician at practice, using language that riffs upon an existing dictionary of musical terms with an eye towards making “vigorous chambers, frivolous rooms.” Lastly, the collection considers the sad song as a collaboration within communities: whether at the bookstore, within a family or between two poets who write in different languages.

NICK THRAN’s previous books include the mixed-genre collection, *If It Gets Quiet Later On, I Will Make a Display* (2023), and three previous collections of poems. *Earworm* (2011) won the 2012 Trillium Book Award for Poetry. His poems have been anthologized in *Best Canadian Poetry* and *The Next Wave: An Anthology of 21st Century Canadian Poetry*. Thran lives on unceded Wolastoqey territory (Fredericton, NB), where he works as an editor and bookseller.

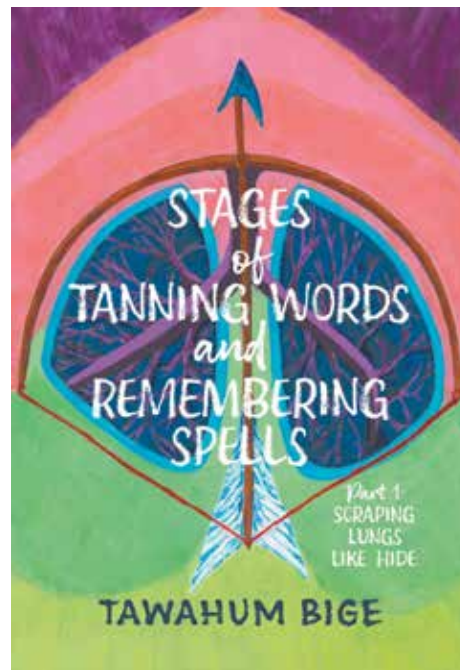
Part 1: Scraping Lungs Like Hide

TAWAHUM BIGE

In their second poetry collection, Tawahum Bige explores belonging and voice of a Two-Spirit Dene youth.

THESE POEMS ARE A stark plunge—an answer to how voice emerges for a young Two Spirit growing up in so-called “Surrey, BC,” far from his Lutselk’e Dene territories. The fundamental thrum in which vocal cords produce sound to whisper, cry, holler and laugh—these inner workings are made corporeal through moments of growth from childhood to young adulthood to show how the seeds sprouted for someone who needed to learn to express to find their path.

TAWAHUM BIGE is a Lutselk’e Dene, Plains Cree poet. Their Scorpio-moon-ass poems expose growth, resistance and persistence as a hopeless Two Spirit Nonbinary sadboy on occupied Turtle Island. With a B.A. in creative writing from Kwantlen Polytechnic University, Bige has performed at countless festivals and had poems featured in numerous publications. His land protection work against the Trans Mountain pipeline expansion led him to face incarceration in 2020. Bige’s debut poetry collection, *Cut to Fortress*, was published by Nightwood Editions in 2022. They reside on unceded Musqueam, Squamish and Tsleil-Waututh territory (Vancouver, BC).

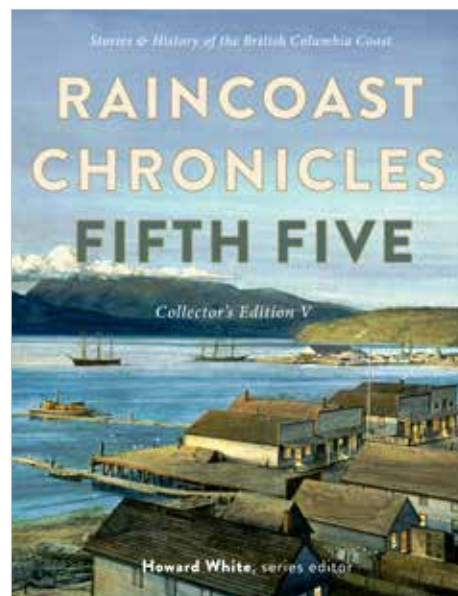

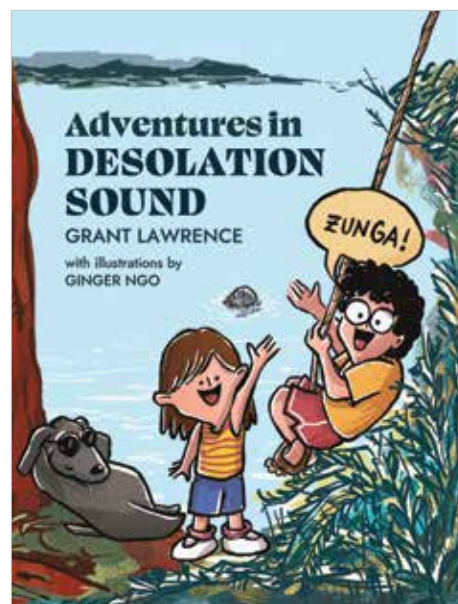

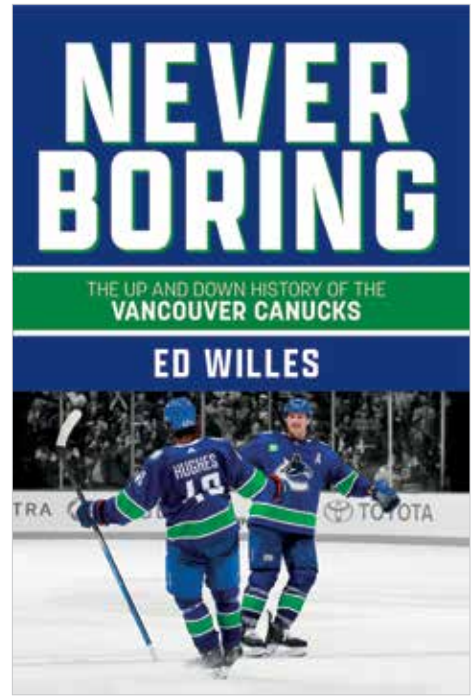
CHEERING FOR THE National Hockey League's Vancouver Canucks over the last half century has required patience, commitment and a forgiving nature. It's not that the Canucks have been uniformly awful or drearily predictable. Far from it (as this past season would attest). But every time they seemed close to delivering the ultimate prize to their fan base—the indomitable faithful—they slipped on a banana peel and tumbled straight into the abyss.

Most of their failings were self-inflicted. The franchise's ownership history is as uneven as its won-loss record. But some have been so random and so accidental, the faithful can legitimately wonder what they did to anger the hockey gods. It started in 1970 with a spin of the carnival wheel, which gifted Hall of Fame centre Gilbert Perreault to the Buffalo Sabres and left the Canucks with Dale Tallon. And it's continued uninterrupted for over fifty years.

For decades, veteran Vancouver hockey writer Ed Willes has had his own vantage point on this team that has, in his words, "been haunted by dark and unnatural forces since its inception." And Willes's knowledge extends far beyond the most infamous chapters of the story. As this irreverent, often bitterly funny chronicle shows, the litany of woe stretches back farther and runs deeper than many Canucks fans realize, and stars several of the biggest names in hockey history.

Willes's account tells the story of a uniquely confounded franchise and its obsessive followers, who have thus far been denied the thrill of a Stanley Cup championship. Their consolation has been the dubious comfort of wallowing in collective misery.

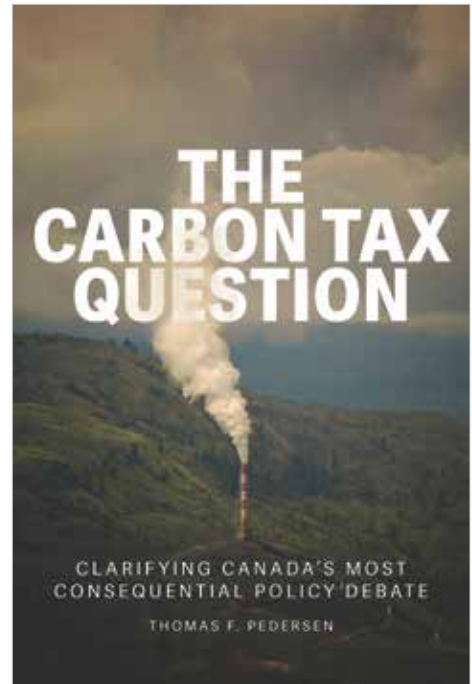

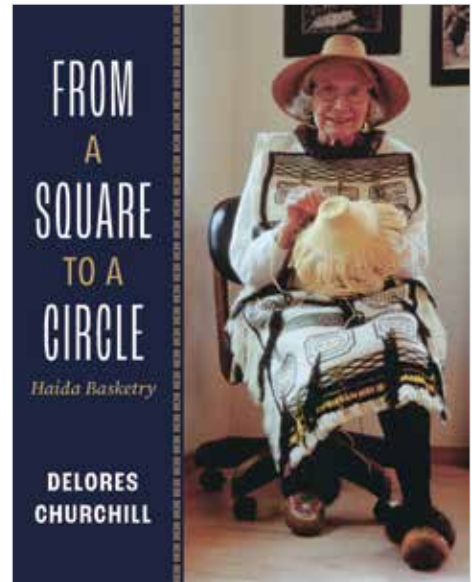
PART MEMOIR, PART how-to guide, this book shines light on Delores's weaving teachers, including her strong-minded mother Selina (Ilst'ayaa), whose teachings Delores once resisted as a child. The Haida are connected to weaving through their history, which goes back thousands of years ago as shown through discoveries like the 4,000-year-old baskets at south Baranof.

Walk with Delores as she harvests cedar bark for baskets, Selina teaching "by modelling and then leaving the learner to imitate." Learn the weaving harvest and preparation terminology. Follow the steps of how to prepare cedar bark, harvest spruce roots, and learn natural dye recipes. Photos and diagrams are visual aids that accompany the steps to Haida weaving techniques and instructions.

Having passed her skills on to hundreds of people, believing that "weaving belongs to all of us," Delores wishes to share the knowledge of basketweaving where beginners and skilled weavers are able to express their distinct selves, just as every coastal Indigenous weaving style is unique. The love for basketweaving displayed in Delores's writing is sure to make readers yearn to try their own hand at the craft.

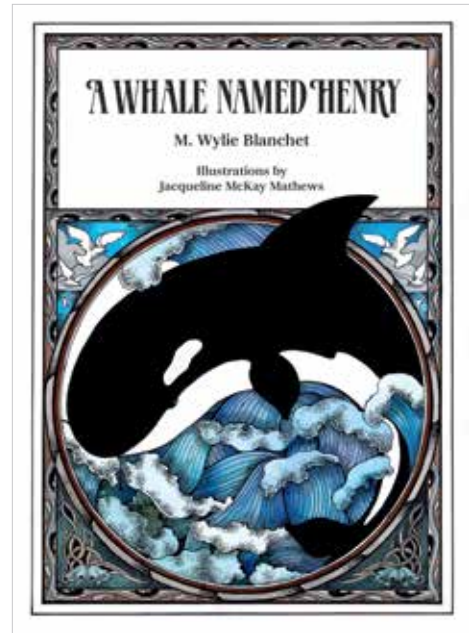

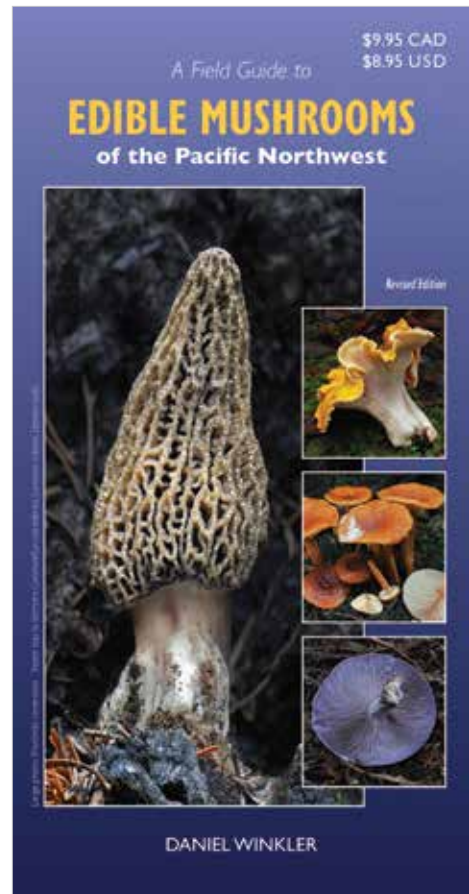

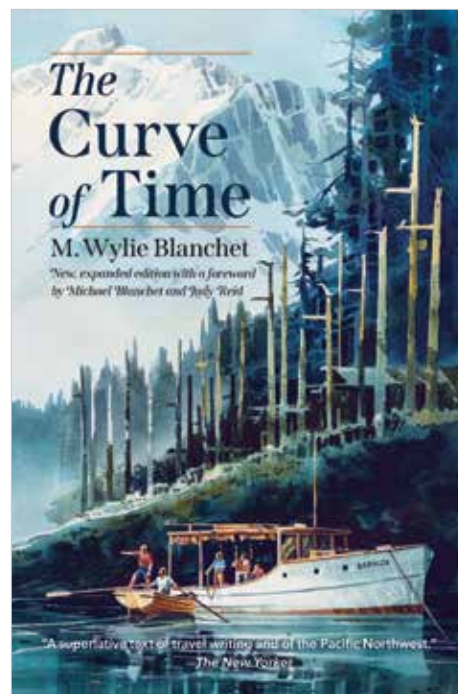
WIDOWED AT THE age of thirty-five, Muriel Wylie Blanchet packed up her five children in the summers that followed and set sail aboard the twenty-five-foot *Caprice*. For fifteen summers, in the 1920s and 1930s, the family explored the coves and islands of the BC coast, encountering settlers and hermits, hungry bears and dangerous tides, and falling under the spell of the region's natural beauty.

Driven by curiosity, the family followed the quiet coastline, and Blanchet—known as Capi, after her boat—recorded their wonder as they threaded their way between the snowfields, slept under the bright stars and wandered through Indigenous winter villages left empty in the summer months.

The Curve of Time weaves the story of these years into a memoir that has inspired generations to seek out their own adventures on the wild West Coast. First published in 1961, less than a year before the author died, Blanchet's captivating work has become a classic of travel writing, and one of the bestselling BC books of all time.
