Dear friends,

Mindful of the world we are building for future generations, Twirl and its parent company, Bayard Group, have been working to continuously reduce our carbon footprint and improve our impact on forest resources. We have at our disposal tools to select our partners in the entire book production chain on environmental, social, and economic criteria, and thus guarantee more ecologically responsible purchasing.

Below are just a few of the many practices we have adopted as part of this commitment:

- Our manufacturing teams look for paper with *lower carbon dioxide emissions*, as paper manufacturing has a strong impact on the carbon footprint of books.

- Editorial and sales teams keep the environment in mind as they make *design choices*: adjusting print runs, and choosing optimized formats and/or more easily recyclable embellishments.

- The paper on which we print our books comes from *sustainably managed forests* or is *PEFC- or FSC-labeled*.

- For our fabric toy and bath books, we prefer *reinforced, recyclable cardboard packaging*. The recycling of our packaging material is an important part of the sustainability of the industry. Paper material can be recycled up to five times.

- Whenever possible, we have chosen to *replace single-use plastic and packaging with paper or cardboard*. However, a few of our books need to be protected with plastic film—the risk being that damaged books will be scrapped and destroyed, which would contribute to greater waste.

Our commitment is ongoing, and we are making new and better choices each year. Thank you for your support and encouragement.

Eating and Drinking

All animals need food to survive. Some animals are carnivores, who eat mostly meat. Others are herbivores, who eat mostly plants. Many are omnivores, who eat both meat and plants.

The Food Web

The food web describes the order in which animals eat to survive. Plants are eaten by small creatures, which are in turn eaten by big creatures, which are eaten by even bigger animals. When a plant or an animal is missing, the food web can be affected and entire groups of animals may disappear.

Sharks have many rows of teeth, some as many as 15 rows! The teeth fall out and grow back in regularly.

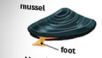

Volcanoes Everywhere
There are approximately 1,500 active volcanoes around the world.

Lift the flap

There are numerous volcanoes on the ocean floor. They're called submarine volcanoes.

Earth is made up of several layers. The top layer is the crust. Below it is a layer called the mantle, and deep in the center is the core.

Inside Earth, it's very hot! It can reach about 10,000° Fahrenheit (6,000° Celsius).

The outer layer of Earth is made up of gigantic pieces, known as tectonic plates, that fit together like a puzzle. Most volcanoes are located where the plates meet.

The plates are always on the move, although very slowly. They can pull away from each other or collide with each other.

Sometimes, eruptions of a submarine volcano can form land above the water. Surtsey, an island off the coast of Iceland, was created from four years of volcanic eruptions in the 1960s.

Volcanoes that are not expected to erupt ever again are considered extinct. Mount Kilimanjaro in Tanzania is a volcano made up of three cones, two of which are extinct.

Some volcanoes are in the middle of a plate. One example is Piton de la Fournaise (Peak of the Furnace) on Réunion, an island in the Indian Ocean.

Dormant volcanoes, such as the ones in Auvergne, France, have not erupted in a very long time, but they may erupt again.

Active volcanoes, such as Mount Pelée in Martinique, have recently erupted and are likely to erupt again.
