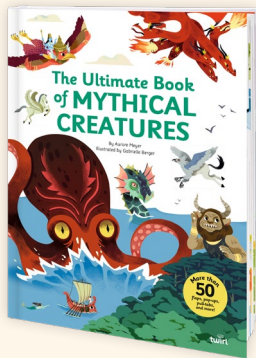

Winged Beings

The skies are filled with legendary creatures that flap, swoop, and glide—bringing terror, breathing fire, or even symbolizing hope.

Mothman is a large human-like creature with wings and two hypnotic red eyes that glow. This frightening monster from American folklore seems to appear just before a disaster occurs. Can this strange beast be a supernatural messenger sent to forewarn people?

Called the "lightning bird," the **Impundulu** is a supernatural spirit that's known in southern Africa to be the servant of a traditional healer. This destructive creature can create lightning and thunder with its wings and razor-sharp talons. It can also transform into a human. What's more, it loves to feed on the blood of its victims!

The **roc** is an enormous bird of prey. According to legends from Arabia and Persia, this creature has gigantic wings that can blot out the sun and make you think it's nighttime. And it's so strong that it can pick up large animals—even an elephant!

Watch out, rooster **Mitsukawa** is going to eat you up! This gargantuan dragon-bird from Philippine mythology is believed to cause eclipses by devouring the sun and the moon. People shout and bang gongs to get the beast to release its prey. Otherwise, Earth might be next!

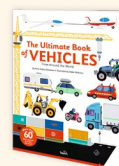
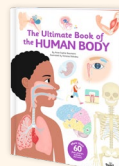
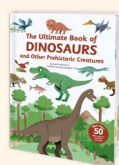
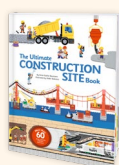
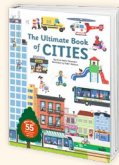
Beware of the **harpies**: Part woman and part bird, harpies are winged creatures from Greek mythology. Sent by Zeus, King of the gods, to punish evildoers, they steal food and leave behind a horrible stench. These frightening monsters can also carry people away. Unfortunately, harpies are so quick that no one can catch them!

With the body of a man and the head and wings of an eagle, the divine **Garuda** takes Vishnu, the Hindu god, wherever he wants to go. This strong and wise winged creature was born from Hindu and Buddhist traditions, and represents victory over evil.

The immortal **phoenix** has its origins in Greek mythology, but it also exists in the legends of other cultures. Each cycle of its life can last 500 to more than 1,000 years. At the end of one life, the creature sets its nest on fire. From the ashes of the flames, a new phoenix hatches, representing hope. When it emerges, it is ready to live out its own long life. This cycle of life and rebirth never ends!

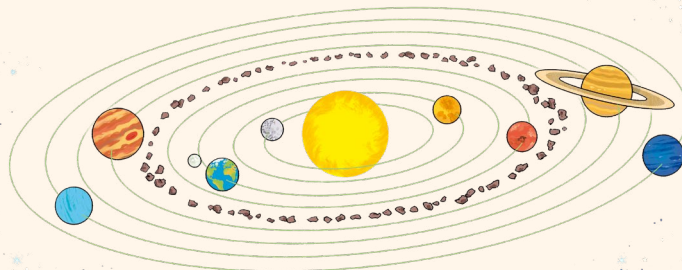
A fly that can command demons? That would be **Beetzebub**, a demonic spirit with insect-like features, and a pair of horns (often called "lord of the flies"). It's commonly associated with the evils of temptation, pride, and greed. And when it's angry, it howls like a wolf and breathes fire!

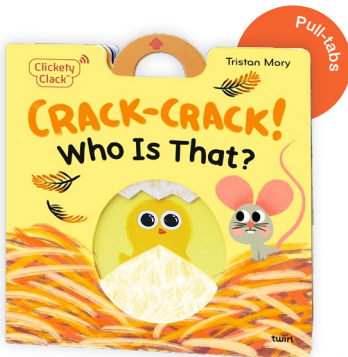




Tristan Mory
