We surveyed Wattpad users to learn about their book buying and book reading habits

Nearly half of Wattpadders surveyed said they would purchase a book even after reading the same book on Wattpad.

- Over one-third of Wattpadders spent more than \$150 on books in the last six months.
- 65% of those surveyed purchased their last book themselves, with their own money.
