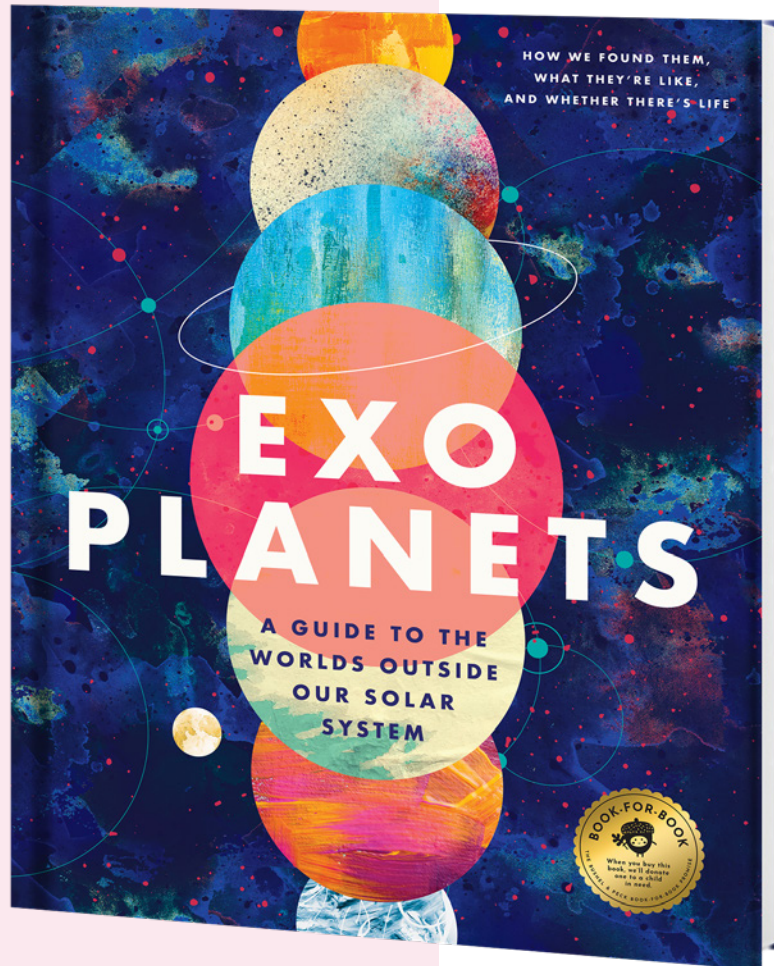
ABOUT THE AUTHOR

First exhibited in 1886, *A Sunday Afternoon on the Island of La Grande Jatte* is one of the most famous paintings of the 19th century. It is also a classic example of Pointillism, a painting technique where small dots of color are applied to create the illusion of a larger image. The painting depicts Parisians enjoying the cool shade on a hot afternoon along the Seine River. This location was a real place; though largely developed today, parts of the riverbank are still a public park.

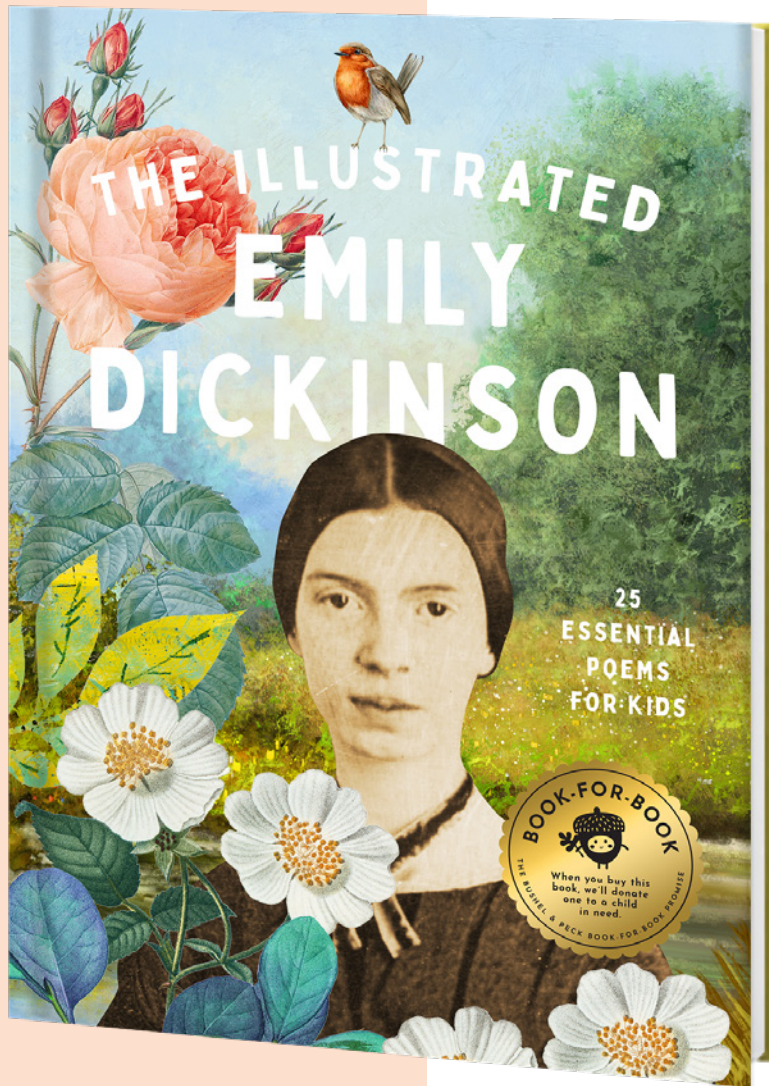
