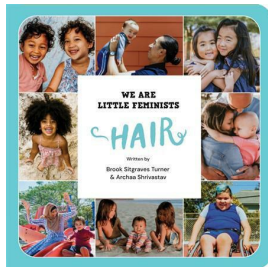

Created for 0-5-year-olds: the book's photographs help infants, toddlers, and preschoolers to recognize faces, hair, and bodies that are both different and like their own.

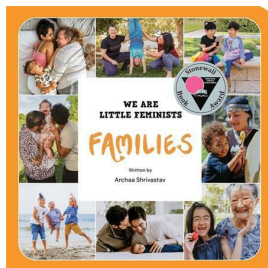

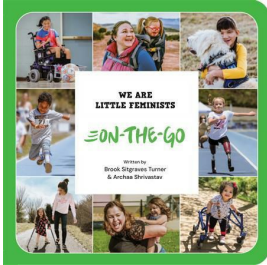
